# Strategies on Data Sharing to MoPR Dashboard

- Currently Health Schemes/ Programs data is collected at the facility level by the State.
- Different data points are collected at various levels starting from SHC to District and State level Hospital.
- Some of the schemes collect beneficiary details while others don't.
- Currently no data for the LIF indicators mapped to MoHFW at the Gram Panchayat level.
- Health facilities are being set up according to population based on IPHS norms and each facility may cater to multiple Gram Panchayats.

HOW MINISTRIES CAN HELP IN COLLECTION OF DATA FOR THE INDICATORS WHICH ARE PRESENTLY NOT CAPTURED.

- Through the DISHA portal process of LGD seeding of health facilities is ongoing.
- After LGD seeding is available at facility level; data maybe mapped at the Gram Panchayat level.
- Data which are currently available only through periodic population-based surveys (NFHS/SRS) at national/state/district levels may be accepted as such considering feasibility and technical considerations.

#### Expected Outcome (from Point of PDI)

Completion of LGD seeding of Health Care Facilities and subsequent transfer of available data through web/API.

#### ROAD AHEAD

- Increased participation of PRIs in improving health outcomes through PDI.
- Dovetailing and aligning of other data collection initiatives at local level such as Mission Antyodaya.
- Encouraging Convergence, Collaboration and Competition among panchayats leading to better health outcomes.


- A concept of 'Healthy Villages' has been envisaged for achieving Sustainable Development Goals in Panchayati Raj Institutions.
- The health functionaries at the village and Sub-Centre/Health & Wellness Centre levels, along with the support of Gram Panchayats, are making substantial efforts for elimination of TB.
- 'TB Mukt Panchayat' is an initiative in continuation of the above efforts. The objective of the Initiative is to empower the Panchayati Raj Institutions to realize the extent and magnitude of problems associated with TB, take necessary actions towards solving them, create healthy competition amongst Panchayats and to appreciate their contribution.

# Mapping of Local Indicators with Schemes

- 1. The information/data on few Key Performance Indicators (KPIs including LIF-Tuberculosis incidence per 1000 people), on the basis of which the claims will be submitted and verified, will be captured online Panchayat-wise/Village-wise from Ni-Kshay Portal (CTD, MoHFW) and will flow to e-Gram Swaraj portal (MoPR) after the integration of two portals
- Certificates for 'TB Mukt Panchayats', with one year validity, will be issued to qualified Gram Panchayats every year by District Magistrate/District Collector/Deputy Commissioner on World TB Day (24th March).

# Mapping of identified LIFs with Dashboard

- The LIF incidence of Tuberculosis per 1000 population in Gram Panchayat including other key performance indicators, information will be captured in Ni-Kshay portal (CTD, MoHFW).
- The information in the indicators will be made available to Gram Panchayats by integration of Ni-kshay with eGramswaraj for monitoring and submission of claims

# Strategies on Data Sharing to MoPR Dashboard

• Multiple meetings were held under the chairpersonship of the Additional Secretary, MoPR, with NIC teams of MoPR & MoH&FW in which it was decided to execute the whole certification process online (from submission to verification claims) for TB Mukt Panchayat through the integration of MoPR portal and Ni-Kshay Portal.

# HOW MINISTRIES CAN HELP IN COLLECTION OF DATA FOR THE INDICATORS WHICH ARE PRESENTLY NOT CAPTURED.

The information/data on few Key Performance Indicators (KPIs), on the basis of which the claims will be submitted and verified, will be captured online Panchayat-wise/Village-wise from Ni-Kshay Portal (CTD, MoHFW) and will flow to e-Gram Swaraj portal (MoPR) after the integration of two portals.

 Number of Panchayats declared 'TB free' under 'TB Mukt Panchayat' initiative annually.

- Mapping of all TB patients,
   Panchayat-wise/Village-wise, with LGD code.
