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# Suggestions in respect of Local Indicators & its data Points (in respect of revision, modification & addition (if any)



#### **Feedback on PDI Portal**

- 1. On Submission of data entry, It has to be redirected to the concerned Indicator/Data Point where it is left blank, instead of scrolling up and down.
- 2. Conversion into local language tool should be available in the PDI Portal against each parameter/Data Point so as to enable easy of conversion.
- 3. Data Verification Offices, Field Offices and Data Source Registers:

  The Parameters which are populated should have provision to override with the State Specific terminology for the Particular State, instead of create/add new Parameter.
- 4. A Dedicated Demo Site provided for State level, District level and further hands-on Sessions.
- 5. Configure Data Points of Indicators should have a provision of Check box to pick the Theme wise Multiple Group may be Provided to analyse the data as per the requirement.
- 6. Application has to be more User-Friendly and make it very less Number of Clicks.
