Challenges faced during data validation process at GP level

- 1. The availability of line departmental data and pre-populating of data is a major concern.**
- 2. Absence of the Gram Panchayat Level data bank and comparative correction of data is a challenging job.**
- 3. The presence of line departmental functionaries are limited.**
- 4. Institutional records are not available at GP level.**
- 5. Mentioning of field office as Gram Panchayat office for ease of understanding at GP level.**
- 6. Character limit to be reviewed under state specific configuration when adding Department's full name**
