2	Criteria for selection of GPs for Data collection	Data should be related to themes and authorized by concern line department and revalidated by panchayat secretary and mukhiya.

Data from the line department was also collected and presented to the team by panchayat secretary also gathered and presented data from the line departments to the group. The process also marked the contribution of BPROs and other GPs level staff.

Challenges faced during data validation process at GP level

1. Survey data register/file is not available in proper format at GPs level
2. Need co-ordination from higher level to Gps level.
3. Data not easily available by different line department.
4. Progress report not be shared by the line department to Panchayat.
5. There is no such portal for sharing GPs Data
6. Collecting data from the police station is very difficult.
7. Related all Concern department need to instruct their block/GPs level office to share their survey data to Panchayat.
8. Authenticity(quality of data being genuine and real) of available data ensure by the line department.



Feedback on PDI Portal

1. It's a good initiative by MoPR to collecting information from all line department.
2. PDI Website is user friendly and its help GP to make proper plans with coordination of line department.
3. Add, Modify and Delete option should be their at State and block level.
4. State should authorized to create line department and related BPs and GPs.
5. Data Repetition
6. View and add option should be in same page.
7. Their should be option to assigning office to the facilitator.
8. Sometimes page getting crashed while adding data at state level.
9. should be option to rest and forgot password.
