- 2. Malkapuram grama panchayat of Thullur Mandal Guntur District**
- 3. Tarakaturu Grama Panchayat of Guduru Mandal Krishna District**
- 4. Kesara Grama Panchayat of Kanchikacharla Mandal NTR District**
- 5. Chintaluru Grama Panchayat of Prattipadu mandal Kakinada district**



# Process followed for Data Collection

# Challenges faced during data validation process at GP level

1. Some of the Information with respect to PDI is not State Specific
2. Some information is not relevant to state
3. Certain information is repeated twice and thrice eg. MMR
4. Duplication of indicators were found(25-26-27-28)(47-48-49-50)



# Suggestions in respect of Local Indicators & its data Points (in respect of revision, modification & addition (if any))

- Many of the aspects covered under Local indicator frame work are not state specific which are to be changed as per the structural set up in the States.
- Duplication of 6 Indicators was found which is to be rectified
