- 2. Malkapuram grama panchayat of Thullur Mandal Guntur District
- 3. Tarakaturu Grama Panchayat of Guduru Mandal Krishna District
- 4. Kesara Grama Panchayat of Kanchikacharla Mandal NTR District
- 5. Chintaluru Grama Panchayat of Prattipadu mandal Kakinada district

Challenges faced during data validation process at GP level

- 1. Some of the Information with respect to PDI is not State Specific
- 2. Some information is not relevant to state
- 3. Certain information is repeated twice and thrice eg. MMR
- 4. Duplication of indicators were found(25-26-27-28)(47-48-49-50)



Suggestions in respect of Local Indicators & its data Points (in respect of revision, modification & addition (if any)

- Many of the aspects covered under Local indicator frame work are not state specific which are to be changed as per the structural set up in the States.
- Duplication of 6 Indicators was found which is to be rectified

Plan of Action for Rolling out PDI in the State/UT

- After this session of workshop we could able to assess the seriousness in preparation of PDI in the state.
- APSIRD as specific is ready to coordinate with PR&RD and also with all line departments for conducting training to all the field functionaries from District level to Grama Panchayat Level on PDI
- We want to adhere strictly to the Guidelines issued by the MoPR while conducting PDI survey in the state.
- When ever State Specific issues and technical issues identified, we will coordinate with the MoPR team for sorting out those issues to conduct PDI survey frictionless.
- We will prepare time line for the completion of PDI in coordination with CPR&RD as per the schedule given by the MoPR.
