- * Allocation for 2022-23: ₹123 Cr
- * Allocation for 2023-24: ₹143.11 Cr
- * Allocation for 2024-25: ₹163.98 Cr
- * Distribution Ratios (Area: Population = 50:50, GPs:ZPs = 70:30)
