*Vide letter no. RDD-Pnch/38/2023(CC:7135150), dated 14th October 2024 from Department of Rural Development &Panchayati Raj, Jammu & Kashmir, requested to accord approval for the construction of 500 GP Bhawan amounting to Rs.100 crore and construction of 500 additional rooms for co-location of CSCs in GP Bhawan amounting to Rs.25 crore, which were accorded in-principle approval by CEC in its meeting held on 29.02.2024 subject to condition that UT will complete the preliminary activities needed for starting the work and then approach the MoPR for enhancement in the budget summary for executing the work. It has been mentioned din the letter that the land has been identified for 476 GP Bhawan and the process of preparation of DPRs has already been started. Further, it has also been mentioned in the above letter that Rs.33.70 crore will be saving from other approved components (CB&T-Rs.26.84 cr., Institutional support- Rs. 3.78 cr., PMU- Rs.2.58 cr., e-Enablement – Rs.0.50 cr.). Accordingly, the revised budget summary has been worked out, which has increased from Rs.232.62 crore to **Rs.327.12 crore** {Rs.232.62 cr.+ Rs.125 cr. + Rs.3.20 cr. (enhancement in Project Management & IEC) – Rs.33.70 cr.}.
