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Minutes of Meeting held on 1st July 2025 regarding the RFP for Selection of Technical Agency for PMU for Panchayat Own Source Revenue (OSR) Enhancement Cell

A pre-Bid meeting was held on 1st July 2025 at 11:00 AM, at the Conference Room, 11th Floor, Jeevan Prakash Building, KG Marg, New Delhi, regarding the RFP for Selection of Technical Agency for PMU for Panchayat Own Source Revenue (OSR) Enhancement Cell.

2. At the outset, the Chair welcomed all the participants to the meeting and highlighted that the program for the augmentation of the Own Source of Revenue (OSR) of the Panchayat is an important program initiated by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj. During the meeting, the following points were discussed:

A. Discussion on Own Source Revenue (OSR) of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs):

- It was clarified that OSR comprises both tax and non-tax sources.
- A few exemplary cases were shared with the participants:
 - A Gram Panchayat in Tamil Nadu with the potential to generate substantial revenue through a beach owned by it located within 50 km of Chennai.
 - A Gram Panchayat in Andhra Pradesh owning a 22 sq. km water body near Amaravati with potential for recreation, hospitality & pisciculture.
 - A Gram Panchayat near Tirupati collecting ₹3.5 crores annually from parking fees.
 - A Gram Panchayat near Mumbai is generating ₹1.5 crores annually, which is being used in the construction of CC roads.
- Emphasis was placed on the untapped potential of rural assets, including water bodies, tourism destinations, and local fairs (melas).
- The need for expert deployment to map, plan, and monetize these assets effectively was also stressed.
- It was clarified that the RFP pertains to two verticals. One for the Atma Nirbhar Panchayats sub-scheme (6 personnel) and the other (2 personnel) for the OSR cell of the Ministry.
