OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Regarding increase in the maximum age of children for whom the Aadhaar authentication by parents may be used for availing the services under PM-JAY

As per current policy of Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY, any child upto the age of 1 year can avail treatment at empanelled hospitals under the scheme using their parents' Ayushman card. Parents are also required to undergo Aadhaar based authentication for the purposes of e-KYC at the time of seeking services under AB PM-JAY for their children of age less than 5 years.

2. However, on the basis of feedback received from certain State Health Agencies, it has been decided to revise this process as follows:
