Theme: *Recognizing the leaders who are raising the bar for e-governance*

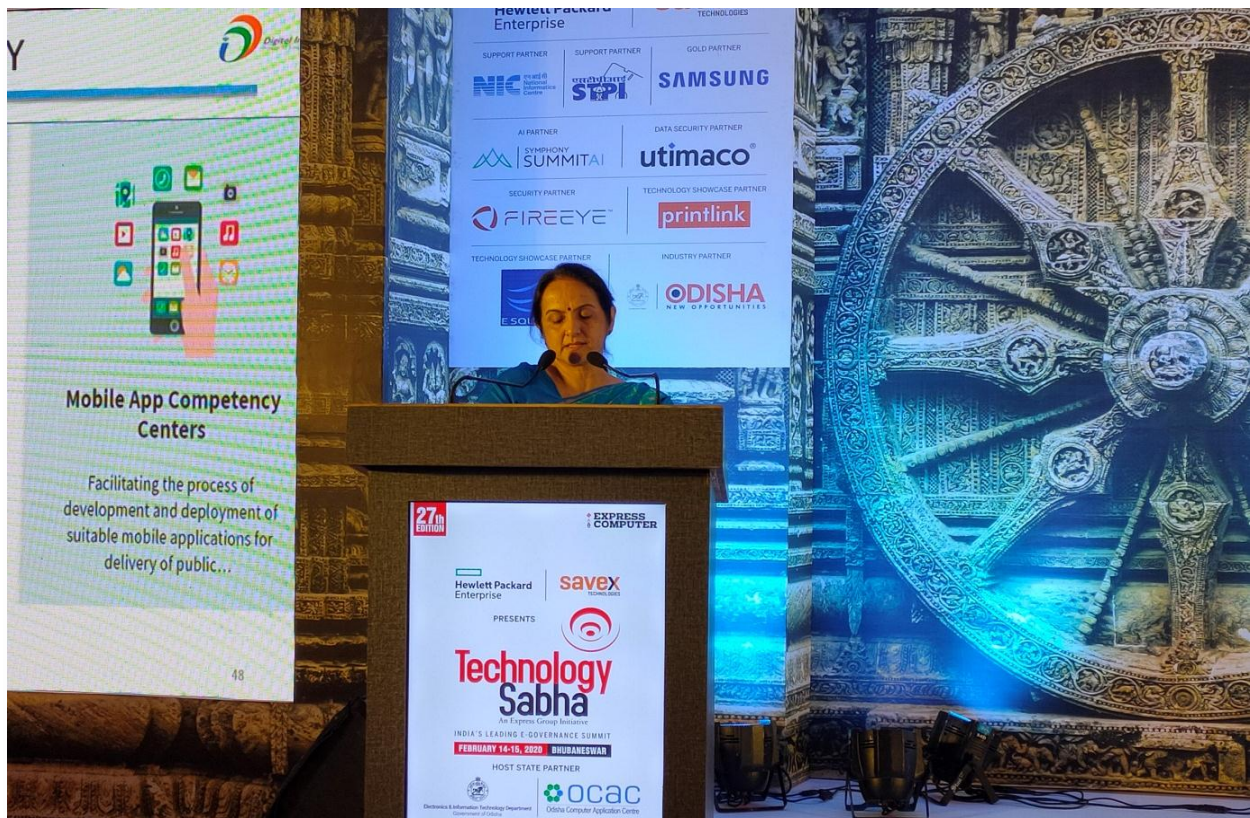
