### CMRF Odisha Portal : A gateway to help Fani victims.

A Website for The Chief Minister's Relief Fund (CMRF) of Odisha (<https://cmrfodisha.gov.in>) has been designed and developed by NIC, Odisha. Through this portal, domestic and foreign donations can be seamlessly and securely received online through NET Banking, Credit cards, Debit Cards using various payment gateways integrated with the portal. Donations to CMRF can also be made through BHIM UPI QR CODE of various banks in India using mobile apps like Google Pay, PhonePe etc.

Payment gateway of ICICI bank (Money2india) has been integrated with the portal for collection of foreign donations. Donors can get receipts through SMS and Email confirming their donation.

The CMRF, Odisha portal has successfully collected donation of amount over INR 10 crores towards *Fani* relief and rebuilt measures.

The IVRFT team from NIC, Bhubaneswar put all its proactive effort and succeeded to help Airport Authority, Bhubaneswar, to resume its International flight operation in Biju Patnaik International Airport, Bhubaneswar from 4<sup>th</sup> of May, the very next day of Fani havoc.

Though the connectivity of ICP with central IVRFT system was down and it was difficult for immigration check of foreign passengers without the central online IVRFT system, the team from NIC, Bhubaneswar could establish an offline local system for PAX clearance to manage UCF and C-Visa. Later on, the offline data seamlessly synchronized with online central IVRFT system, after its full resumption on 16<sup>th</sup> of May 2019.

Any thought process which can't be done by a human in natural way, also can't be done by the AI or ML. The advantages of AI over a human are speed and accuracy.

## TechTalk

### Agile : The ideal approach for e-Gov Projects

*Agile* is globally acclaimed software development methodology endorsed by software project experts for over 20 years. Its success rate is much higher than traditional waterfall model for all sized projects.

Agile development is based on iterative incremental model, in which requirements and solutions evolve through collaboration with project team and user. In this model, the development starts with a limited number of finalized and prioritized user requirements called features. The deliverables are potential working increments, containing features of the product. During the development of e-governance project, requirements are often ambiguous or uncertain. In Agile approach, the ambiguities can be cleared during development process itself through frequent walk-through sessions between users and development team. Hence, Agile can be applied to e-governance project development to achieve success instead of waterfall model which is process-oriented.

There are numbers of frameworks used for Agile. The most popular framework is *Scrum*. Scrum involves different artifacts, roles and events to cater to rapid and flexible response to bring changes for quick and frequent deliveries. Some of the major advantages of Agile are:

- Eliminates ambiguous requirements
- Supports requirement changes which are inevitable
- Big, upfront planning is not required
- Reviewing the working software is better.
- Iterative and incremental development is better.
- Encourages cross functional teamwork.
