Hon'ble Chief Minister of Odisha Launches e-MSME Seva

Shri Naveen Patnaik, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha, has launched 11 Online Services of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Department on 21st November, 2020 under 5T initiatives of the Government of Odisha. The MSME Department provides 23 services under Odisha Right to Public Service Act (ORTPSA), out of which 12 services have already been made online earlier through an automated application titled Administration of Incentive for MSME (AIM). Now, the remaining 11 services were launched.

These 11 services are covered by five independent applications namely Directorate of Export Promotion and Marketing – Online Services (DEPMOS), Online Loan Information System (OLIS), Online Rebate Management System (ORMS), Online Consortium Marketing Information System (OCMIS) and Recommendation for Registration of New Khadi Institution (RRNKI). All these applications are available in a common site <http://odishamsme.nic.in> and called as e-MSME Seva.

Hindu Religious Endowment Website Launched

The official website of Hindu Religious Endowment, Odisha, (<https://hinduendowments.odisha.gov.in>) was launched by Shri Pratap Jena, Hon'ble Minister of Law, Panchayati Raj, Drinking Water & Housing and Urban Development. This site is a repository of information about the Hindu Religious Temples and Mathas. Equipped with many facilities and features, now the website facilitates public by provisioning services like Cause lists, Case status and important

Orders/Judgments. Citizens and litigants can know about their legal disputes pending or disposed in the Commission office. Moreover, GIGW compliant website enables access to the specially challenged citizens. And inclusion of CMS and role based authentication allows different officials to manage the contents with ease.

The Web application, integrated through NIC's ServicePlus platform and complies the PC & PNDT Act, has been designed to facilitate online application for registration and renewal of Ultra Sound Units with online payment facilities. This system enables the applicant to apply online for setting up of an Ultra Sound Unit in Odisha. This application facilitates concerned district authorities to scrutinize the application and issue

Certificates through the system itself. With the help of the system, the District Magistrate can review the status of implementation of registration/ renewal processes of PC & PNDT Clinics and ensure timely registration, renewal & permanent record maintenance.

NIC's Flagship e-Counselling System keeps its promise

Since Decades, NIC's e-Counselling system has been adopted in Odisha, facilitating students to put their choices for different courses sitting at home. The system allots seat using Best-Fit algorithm according to the rank in entrance test, choices given and categories to which the student belongs to. With increasing number of courses, institutes, and so also students every year, admission process becomes a complicated task from and to eliminate such complicity and bringing transparency in the system Government of Odisha has adopted e-Counselling with Technical Assistance from NIC. The portal is integrated with online payment facility along with mail and sms gateway for intimation to candidates. e-Counselling has been enlisted in 5T action plan of Odisha Government. Different admission conducting bodies and premier institutes like Odisha Joint Entrance Examination (OJEE), Swami Vivekananda National Institute of Rehabilitation Training and Research (SVNIRTAR) and others are using e-Counselling platform for Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses namely, B Tech, B.Arch, B.Plan, MBBS, BDS, B.Pharm BHMS, BAMS, MCA, MBA, M.Tech, M.Arch, M.Plan, M. Pharma etc.

NIC, Odisha has developed an end-to-end integrated online product for seed certification process automation named SCAP-NIC which has been implemented in the State of Odisha and Uttarakhand. Seed Certification is a quality assurance system, wherewithal seeds intended for marketing is subject to quality control and inspection. At its simplest, the system certifies the seeds in a bag, that was produced, inspected and graded according to the requirements of Certification Scheme. This entire process includes seed grower's registration, verification, inspection, threshing certificate issue, intake, intake verification, processing, processed stock verification, sampling, testing and tag issue. This e-Governance product facilitating G2C & G2B services, reduces the efforts of officials. This application is completely

workflow based and salient features of this application are:

- Developed using complete open source technology stack.
- Provides Bharat Map integrated GIS Dashboard.
- Provides offline friendly & device agnostic mobile applications for all field level services.
- Mobile applications capturing GPS location of activities.
- Configured Inspection and Testing lab standards to avoid human errors.

This product has already received National e-Governance award and CSI-Nihilent e-Gov Award along with publication in the PM Award Book "New Beginning". Seed Certification Agencies of AP, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Himachal Pradesh are in pipeline to use the product in their States.
