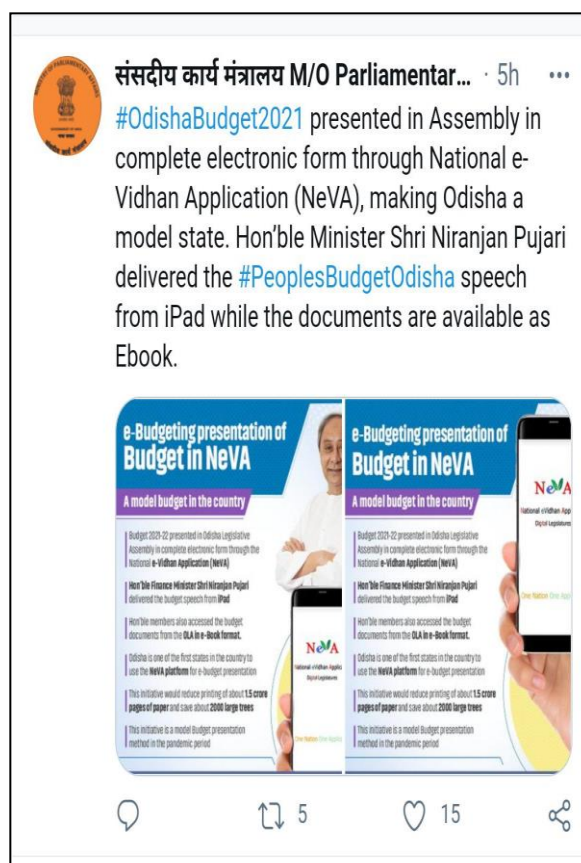


ODISHA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY FIRST TO IMPLEMENT HON'BLE GOVERNOR'S ADDRESS, ECONOMIC SURVEY & STATE BUDGET ESTIMATES ON NeVA IN BUDGET SESSION 2021



Odisha becomes the first state to use NeVA for inside the House Digitisation during the Budget session 2021.

On the first day of current session on 18.02.2021, **Hon'ble Governor's address** was made online on NeVA. Information was shared through e-book for all Hon'ble Members of OLA inside the House. Controller and display module has also been implemented for '**Motion of Thanks**' by Govt Chief Whip.

On 20.02.2021 **Economic survey** was made accessible on NeVA for Hon'ble Members and public.

On 22.02.2021 '**State Budget Estimates**' were laid on the floor of the house by Hon'ble Finance Minister Shri Niranjan Pujari through NeVA e-Book.

The paperless State Budget 2021-22 tabled through digital mode saved 2,000 large trees and reduced paper trail of 1.5 crore pages, official sources said. Odisha is the second State in the country to adopt complete e-budgeting by building digital infrastructure, actively promoting adoption and usage of documents in electronic form.

Finance Minister Niranjan Pujari delivered the budget speech from an iPad. The members of the House accessed the budget documents in an e-book format.

The budget is available on National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) while a dedicated Odisha Budget App is available in app stores.

Odisha govt presents budget for FY22 with Rs 1.7 lakh crore outlay

Bhubaneswar, Feb 22 (PTI) The Odisha government on Monday presented a budget for 2021-22 fiscal with an outlay of Rs 1.7 lakh crore and a thrust on agriculture and infrastructure sectors to boost the state's economy.

The budget for the next fiscal was tabled in the assembly through an electronic system using the National e- Vidhan Application (NeVA) for the first time.

Presenting the annual estimates in two separate parts- "Agriculture Budget" and "General Budget" - Finance Minister Niranjan Pujari said the capital outlay for the next year is projected at Rs 25,788
