Launch of Notification Information System Mobile App at Paralakhemundi, Gajapati District, Odisha



The Android based Mobile App "Notification Information System Gajapati District" was launched by the District Collector Shri Anupam Saha, IAS and Smt. Kabita Roy Das, DDG & SIO, on 30/03/2021 in presence of Smt. Nirupama Mohapatra STD & ASIO (Districts) and Shri T. Balakrishna Murty, DIO at Paralakhemundi.

The objective of the mobile App is to provide the latest information on district level Advertisements, Recruitment notifications, tenders, information about the district, culture & heritage, tourist places & where to stay information and location of important district level offices along with contact numbers to the citizens.

SIO described about the features of the mobile App to Collector Gajapati. SIO also briefed about the District Governance Mobile App Challenge (DGMC) to the Collector Gajapati. The mobile has been developed by the DIO. The Collector appreciated the design of the App and was hopeful that it will enhance the transparency and timely availability of information to the citizens.



Later, SIO and ASIO held discussion with the Collector. SIO briefed about the various projects implemented by NIC.

Collector thanked SIO and ASIO for their visit to Gajapati district.

After the launching program of the Mobile App, SIO & ASIO visited NIC District Centre. They visited all rooms of NIC and VC Studio, UPS room and had a discussion with DIO regarding the 3 phase electric supply to NIC, availability of Air Conditioners, furniture in VC Studio. She also discussed about the role & activities of DIO in Aspirational District Program implementation in the district and implementation of other projects. She discussed on network issues in the district for implementation of online applications. As 5 out of 7 tahasils are situated on geographically hilly areas, it is difficult to cover all the remote villages with Cellular/ Data network due to line of site issue and it is affecting the implementation of eGovernance projects. The remote GPs are depending on Block / Tahasil offices. The progress of BharatNet work is not upto the mark in the district. Now the District administration is focusing on VSAT network for the remote GPs. SIO appreciated the cleanliness of the NIC District Centre.
