The e-Lectures portal under Virtual Tutorial Project (VTP) of Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiskhya Abhiyan (RUSA) is developed and hosted by NIC. At present, the e-Lectures for the core papers of 1st and 2nd Semesters of eleven subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Political Science, Odia, History, English, Psychology, Commerce and Economics have been uploaded in the web portal. e-Lectures for the core papers of remaining semesters of these 11 subjects will be uploaded in the web portal in due course of time.



The site is designed with a mobile first approach. e-Lectures search box, latest videos, syllabus, resources and feedback are prominently displayed on the website to serve both the students as well as faculty members. All video files are hosted at VOD server of Webcast and Multimedia division, NIC, New Delhi. Shri Sambit Kumar Panda, Sr. TD NIC gave a presentation of the portal.
