Utkal University gets e-office

Bhubaneswar: An e-office was launched at the <u>Utkal University</u> on Wednesday under the 5T initiative of the state government in a bid to make office work paperless and ensure more transparency and greater efficiency.

Avaya Kumar Nayak, registrar of the university, said e-office has proved to be useful for remote work, especially during the pandemic. "With the implementation of e-office, the 5Ts (transparency, technology, teamwork, time and transformation) can be achieved," he added.

Kavita Roy Das from the National Informatics Centre (NIC) said e-office is a project under the National e-Governance Plan initiated in 2009. "It has been developed by the NIC and is being implemented through the Centre for Modernizing Government Initiative (CMGI), a society under the administrative control of the general administration and public grievances department of the Odisha government," she added.

Ravenshaw University in Cuttack was the first varsity under the higher education department to implement the e-office initiative. "The Utkal University is the third institution to do so," Sabita Acharya, vice-chancellor of the Utkal University, said.

An official said the digital files cannot be tampered with. "These e-files cannot be misplaced like paper documents. If anybody wants to tamper with a file, the system will show the digital footprint. Sometimes paper documents get damaged in fire accidents. But it will not happen in the case of the e-files," he added.

BHUBANESWAR: To bring in transparency in administration, the Utkal University launched eoffice system on Wednesday.

Launching the initiative, Vice-Chancellor of the university Sabita Acharya said that e-office is an effective tool for transparency, efficiency and accountability. Under the 5T initiative, eoffice which has been developed by National Informatics Centre (NIC) will be implemented by Centre for Modernising Government Initiative (CMGI) - a society under GA department.

In February this year, the Higher Education department had asked all its 12 public universities to implement the e-office system. Under it, digital workplaces will be created and files would be stored in the cloud as a result of which, they cannot be tampered with.

Utkal University is the third varsity in the State to implement the e-office system after Ravenshaw University, Cuttack, and Maharaja Sriram Chandra Bhanja Deo University in Baripada. CMGI project coordinator Pinaki Mohanty said that the e-Office is a very convenient system for the employees and it will reduce their work load.
