eGovernace conference for DIOs inaugurated by Chief Secretary, Odisha

The three-days long e-Governance Conference (DIO Meet-2023) for DIOs and ADIOs of all the 30 districts of Odisha was organised at NIC, Bhubaneswar. Inaugurating the workshop on 14th December, Shri Pradip Kumar Jena, IAS, Chief Secretary, Odisha, highlighted the important role of District Informatics Officers (DIOs) towards effective implementation of eGovernance solutions at grassroots level. He expressed his happiness to note that the capacity building of DIOs is being taken care of in different ways. Stressing upon the 5-Ts mandate of Govt. of Odisha, he wished that DIOs should be dedicated towards implementation of Technology to bring transformation in timely manner.



The Guest of Honor Shri R. Santhanagopalan, IAS, Comm.-cum-Secretary, Labour & ESI, discussed on disruptive technologies and vision ahead to integrate the same in various eGovernnace solutions. Dr. A. K. Hota, DDG & SIO, appraised about various activities of NIC, Odisha and emphasized the contribution of DIOs. The projects profile in the form of Desktop Calendar was released on the occasion. Later, a number of technical sessions on MindsDB, BigChainDB, IPV6, WebSocket, Alexa Skill, IoT architecture etc. were organized and DIOs were felicitated for their best contributions.

State level Workshop on SATHI

(Seed Authentication Traceability & Holistic Inventory)

On 15th December 2023, a state-level workshop unfolded, spotlighting the national initiative SATHI, developed by a collaborative effort of NIC, Odisha, NIC, Delhi and NIC, Maharashtra. The event drew the active participation of NIC officers from both the state and districts, alongside delegates from key entities like the Department of Agriculture, Odisha Seeds & Organic Products Certification Agency, and Odisha State Seed Corporation.



Smt. Mala Mittal, DDG & HoD (Agriculture Informatics Division), NIC, New Delhi, inaugurating the event released the SATHI awareness brochure and introduction video on SATHI modules. She delivered a brief presentation on SATHI, followed by a detailed exposition by Shri. Niladri B Mohanty, Scientist-D & Joint Director (IT), to the engaged audience.

Shri. P K Sahoo, Director, OSSOPCA, shared insights on the pivotal role of seeds, narrating Odisha's progressive journey in this agricultural domain. He unveiled the SATHI Timeline video, a visual journey chronicling SATHI's evolution from its Odisha origin to a comprehensive and scalable initiative, addressing the diverse needs of all states in a remarkably short timeframe.

State Level workshop on eDAR (Electronic Detailed Accident Report)

eDAR is an extension of iRAD (Integrated Road Accident Database) and can make the Accident claims of the victims in a transparent and hassle free manner by the different stakeholders for Motor Accident Compensation Claim. To kick-off the implementation of e-DAR, in Odisha, a state level workshop was organized by State Transport Authority (STA), Odisha, on 16th Dec 2023 at District Culture Office Auditorium, Puri.

Sri Sunil Kumar Bansal, IPS, Director General of Police, Odisha inaugurated the workshop in presence of all DIOs, DRMs and RTOs along with other senior officers from NHAI, R&B, Police, Transport and other stakeholders of Road Safety cell.

Shri Pawan Gupta, Project Manager, iRAD, NICSI, New Delhi, presented and explained how e-DAR would be used by different stakeholders and the requisite forms to be filled up so that it could be helpful to beneficiaries. It was planned to identify Nodal Officers / Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for states / UTs & Nodal Officers for MACT, LSA, Insurance, CWC etc. Authentication over demo site would be shared for practice and stakeholders can share their feedback.



Deliberation on e-Office in One-day OLIC workshop

Regional Official Language Implementation Committee (OLIC), Bhubaneswar, organized a one-day Hindi workshop and technical training at Institute of Physics, Bhubaneswar, on 22nd December, 2023.

Shri Jyoti Prakash Behera, DIO, Jagatsinghpur, joining as Esteemed Speaker, deliberated on various features of e-office, elucidating its benefits and exploring the evolution of different versions. He showcased 'eOffice implementation at Jagatsinghpur district' as a case study, highlighting the strategic approach taken to implement e-office across all administrative levels. He navigated through the intricacies of e-office, highlighting its instrumental role in the implementation of Rajbhasha in official communications and discussed how its MIS report and Knowledge Management System can help the e-office user.



Cyber Surakshit Odisha Conclave

The Economic Times, in collaboration with Zscaler, orchestrated a regional technology summit, centring on the theme of cyber security. In the panel discussion titled "How Zero Trust Can Help State Departments?" officer from NIC Odisha Shri Niladri Bihari Mohanty, Scientist & Joint Director (IT) was invited to share the stage with panellists named Shri Shefeen Ahamed K, IG of Police (Crime Branch & Cyber Crime) & others.

Shri Mohanty elucidated on the profound relationship between trust and risk, emphasising the critical role of the zero-trust security model in the face of infinite risks. He further emphasised how the risk, which was once measurable is now moving towards infinite in the changing scenarios. He presented scenarios illustrating how traditional risk calculation methods have failed in the evolving fintech landscape of India. His analysis about the challenges posed by the shifting dynamics of collaboration, multi-level outsourcing, the transition to managed cloud services, and corporate mergers was well appreciated by the audience.

In the rapidly evolving landscape of modern logistics and inventory management, the pivotal role of Radio-Frequency Identification (RFID) technology is indispensable.

Myth:

RFID technology is infallible and guarantees absolute security and privacy. It is a fool proof means of tracking and identifying items or individuals without any risks as the data inside the chip is invisible to outside.

Truth:

This perception oversimplifies the complexities and potential concerns associated with RFID technology. In reality, RFID systems, while powerful and versatile, are not immune to security and privacy challenges out of the box. Instances of unauthorized people potentially intercepting and cloning RFID signals are there at multiple occasions, leading to unauthorized access or data theft. Additionally, concerns about the tracking and profiling of individuals through RFID technology have raised privacy issues. While security is not achieved by default in RFID systems, employing robust PKI encryption, effective Key management System & other security measures can mitigate such risks.



MindsDB - Build Al using SQL

By leveraging automated machine learning (AutoML), the platform streamlines the arduous process of model selection, hyper parameter tuning, and feature engineering. This automation significantly reduces the time and resources required to develop robust machine learning models, empowering businesses to expedite their data-driven decision-making processes.



Accessible Interface: MindsDB provides an intuitive, user-friendly interface to interact with and leverage powerful machine learning models.

Data Integration: Users can connect their data sources, whether structured or semi-structured, to the MindsDB platform.

Transparency: A distinctive feature of MindsDB is its emphasis on explainable Al. The platform provides explanations and visualizations that detail how the Al models arrive at their predictions.

Integration and Deployment: Once a model is trained, MindsDB facilitates easy integration into existing systems or workflows. It provides APIs and integrations that enable users to deploy the model and make predictions in real-time applications or environments.

Through open-source contributions, educational initiatives, and collaborative partnerships, MindsDB fuels knowledge sharing and collective growth, propelling the field of AI forward.
