Shri Rajiv Rathi, Deputy Director General & State Coordinator, Odisha visited Odisha State Centre (OSC), NIC, Bhubaneswar on 19th March, 2024. Officers of NIC, Odisha welcomed him on his arrival at the Bhubaneswar Airport.

On his arrival at OSC, Bhubaneswar he was welcomed by Dr. Ashok Kumar Hota, DDG & SIO; Dr. Rama Krushna Das, DDG & ASIO and other officers of OSC, Bhubaneswar.



He inaugurated the newly renovated Meeting Room at the OSC and interacted with the HoDs and other senior officers on various activities of the Centre.
