
Launching of DAMPS - Pranisampad in the State of Odisha

On this occasion, objective and benefits of the application have been highlighted. This web enabled system is for collecting initial information from fields (starting from Revenue Circles) on animals (milch, draught and poultry) died in disasters which helps the Competent Authority in monitoring, verifying, approving, analyzing at each stage of administrative levels and accordingly the estimated financial assistance as applicable for replacement of the dead animals disburses directly to the bank accounts of the owner of the animals through iFMS.

FEATURES OF THE SYSTEM

- Web enabled PIR data capturing directly from affected location.
- Secured login-based authentications & Role based authorizations
- Dashboard based display and analysis of cases and their status at different levels, assistance funds approved/sanctioned/disbursed/pending status at state level
- Provision for Uploading of documents for NOK details and identification of beneficiaries
- Digital Order Sheet creation and work flow enabled Forwarding/Reforwarding of order sheets to next/ previous level of administrative hierarchy
- Statistical reports generation at district and state level IFMS integration for disbursement of assistance through DBT.

- Budget Head wise Financial Approval by FA of SRC office
- Bill preparation and submission by DDO of SRC office
- Bill verification & movement by DBT
- Verification & Payment by IFMS through e-Kuber
