VIRTUAL TRAINING ON ePROSECUTION

eProsecution is a web-based platform of the Ministry of Home Affairs developed under the **Inter-operable Criminal Justice System (ICJS)** framework to streamline prosecution processes for the Government. It integrates with CCTNS and eCourts for real-time case data sharing, enabling prosecutors to provide legal opinions, scrutinize charge sheets, track cases, and monitor disposals. The system promotes transparency, accountability, and speedy justice delivery. In the State of Odisha, Directorate of Public Prosecution (DPP) is implementing the eProsecution App under the ease guidance of Director with 31 Deputy Directors at 30 district location and DPP office(HQ). As proposed, a training-cum-sensitisation programme has been organised at VC Hall (ground floor), NIC, Odisha on 14 August 2025 at 11.00AM.

The training session commenced under the esteemed leadership of Shri Ajit Kumar Pattnaik, OSPS, Director (In-Charge), Directorate of Prosecution (DPP), and was graced by the presence of Shri Malay Kumar Das, Sr. Director (IT) & ASIO, NIC Odisha, and Shri S. P. Dash, Sr. Director (IT) & State Coordinator for ICJS, NIC Odisha.

The session was conducted virtually by Shri Piyush Srivastav, a key member of the eProsecution Project Management Unit (PMU) at NIC Headquarters.
