DRIVING DIGITAL GOVERNANCE: TRANSPARENT E-LOTTERY SETTLEMENT OF RETAIL LIQUOR SHOPS IN ODISHA (2026-27)

The Odisha Excise Department successfully launched its 17-phase e-Lottery process on 5th May 2026, for the settlement of retail liquor shops for the 2026–27 excise year. This massive digital initiative covered 1,055 Indian-Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) OFF Shops and 197 Country Liquor (CL) Shops, attracting a total of 29,018 applications (26,177 for IMFL OFF and 2,841 for CL) from across India. The process concluded with a significant collection of over Rs. 842 crores in non-refundable application fees.

NIC Odisha's Pivotal Contribution:

The entire settlement process was powered by the e-Abakari portal (<https://stateexcise.odisha.gov.in>), developed and maintained by NIC Odisha. NIC's involvement was critical at both the state and district levels:

- **Technical Framework:** NIC provided the digital infrastructure for secure online application submissions and document uploads.
- **District Support:** District Informatics Officers (DIOs) served as key members of Scrutiny and Lottery Committees, overseeing the verification of applicant data and technical validation.
- **Transparency & Accountability:** To ensure public confidence, NIC facilitated real-time displays of lottery proceedings and immediate entry of winners into the portal. A major highlight was the mandatory screen recording of the winner-entry process to create a verifiable audit trail. In several districts, NIC also deployed technical personnel (FMS and DRM) to manage network connectivity and uninterrupted internet services.

District Highlights:

District reports underscore the high level of participation and the efficiency of the digital system:

- **High Volume Districts:** Puri recorded the highest number of applications at 1,791 for 54 shops, with the Konark IMFL shop alone receiving 209 applications. Other high-interest districts included Sundargarh/Rourkela (1,692 applications), Cuttack (1,585 applications) and Keonjhar (1,163 applications).
- **Large Scale Operations:** Angul successfully processed 1,014 applications for 53 shops, while Kendrapara managed 1,092 applications for 64 shops.
- **Diverse Participation:** Even in smaller districts like Nabarangpur, 958 applications were received for just 13 shops, demonstrating the widespread competitive interest.

The successful execution of this e-Lottery reflects a landmark achievement in digital governance, ensuring a fair, transparent and technology-driven settlement process across the state.

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ANGUL DISTRICT

The lottery for settlement of IMFL “OFF” and Country Liquor Shops for the Excise Year 2026–27 was successfully conducted on 2nd June 2026 at the Sabhaghar, Angul. All the committee members including Additional District Magistrate, Superintendent of Excise, District Informatics Officer (DIO), NIC, Angul and Nizarat Officer, Angul were present during the event.

The District Informatics Officer, NIC, played a significant role in the entire process as a member of both committees, the DIO supervised the digital scrutiny of applications, verification of supporting documents, management of computerized lottery operations, and deployment of IT infrastructure. The technical support provided by NIC significantly enhanced the transparency, accuracy, and efficiency of the selection process.

A total of 1014 applications were received against 53 notified IMFL “OFF” and Country Liquor Shops. The lottery was conducted through a transparent and technology-enabled system, ensuring fairness and equal opportunity for all applicants. The lottery process was conducted successfully in a transparent, fair & efficient manner with active participation from all committee members and applicants.

BALANGIR DISTRICT

The lottery process for grant of India Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) OFF Shops in Balangir District was successfully conducted on 2nd June 2026 at 10:30 AM in the Conference Hall of Collectorate, Balangir. The online application process was facilitated through the State Excise Department portal, <https://stateexcise.odisha.gov.in>, which has been developed and is being maintained by National Informatics Centre (NIC), Odisha. A total of 532 applications were received from 357 applicants for 21 IMFL OFF Shops in Balangir District.

NIC, Balangir played a key role in ensuring the smooth conduct of the entire process. Shri Manish Kumar, District Informatics Officer (DIO), NIC Balangir, served as a member of the lottery committee and provided technical assistance for downloading applications and documents, scrutiny of applicant data and facilitating the overall lottery process in coordination with the Excise Department and District Administration.

The lottery process was conducted under the chairmanship of the Collector & District Magistrate, Balangir, in the presence of the Additional District Magistrate (General), Superintendent of Excise, Deputy Collector and other officials and the District Informatics Officer (DIO). BOUDH DISTRICT

The lottery process for the settlement of privileges for the retail sale of India Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) 'OFF' shops for the year 2026-27 in Boudh District was conducted on 2nd June 2026 at Sadhabana Sabha Gruha, Collectorate Boudh. NIC District Centre, Boudh played a vital role in the process by assisting the committee in the digital scrutiny of applicants' documents. DIO was also a member of the scrutiny committee.

The lottery was conducted in the presence of the District Collector, ADM, DIO, Excise Superintendent, SDPO, Boudh, and Deputy Collectors of the district. On 29th May 2026, the e-lottery was held for 43 Country Liquor Shops against a total of 451 applications and on 2nd June 2026, the e-lottery was held for 94 IMFL Shops against a total of 1,134 applications, at the New Conference Hall, Collectorate, Cuttack. Altogether, 1,585 applications were received against 137 shops in the Excise District, Cuttack District.

The lottery process was conducted successfully in a transparent, fair, and efficient manner, with active participation from all committee members and applicants. The Superintendent of Excise extended his gratitude to the DIO, NIC, for providing seamless technical support.

DEOGARH DISTRICT

GANJAM DISTRICT

Consequent upon the directions issued from NIC State Headquarters, Bhubaneswar and from the Excise Directorate, Cuttack, to extend technical support to the Excise Department to carry out the Lottery drawl activity, NIC Ganjam took active participation in adherence to the guidelines. As a part of the District Level Scrutiny Committee, Shri Ranajeet Kumar Das, DIO Ganjam along with other committee members chalked-out, monitored and executed all the activities to ensure completion of the whole process with maximum transparency and diligence.

The sale notice was published for Ganjam Excise District on 5th May 2026 and 22nd May 2026 in e-Abakari Portal under careful checks and verification by the DIO Ganjam. A total of 521 applications were received for 45 IMFL Off shop. The sale Notice was published for Berhampur Excise district on 8th May 2026 till 26th May 2026 in e-Abakari Portal under careful checks and verification by the DIO Ganjam. A total of 806 application received for 31 IMFL Off shop. All the applications were meticulously scrutinized and the final list was submitted to the Collector Ganjam for approval.

The lottery drawing event was organized for Ganjam Excise District on 29th May 2026 and for Berhampur Excise District on 2nd June 2026 where the Shri Das, DIO NIC played a pivotal role in planning, drawing of a lottery and updation of the provisionally won applicant in the e-Abakari portal. The lottery drawl process was carried out successfully for all the 45 shops for Ganjam Excise District as well as 31 shops for Berhampur Excise District and the details of provisionally won was uploaded to the e-Abakari portal.

JAGATSINGHPUR DISTRICT

In compliance with the directives of NIC State Headquarters, Bhubaneswar and the Excise Directorate, Cuttack, NIC Jagatsinghpur provided comprehensive technical support for the lottery-based allocation of 25 IMFL OFF shops and 12 Country Liquor shops through the e-Abakari Portal.

As a member of the District Level Scrutiny Committee, Sri Sujit Kumar Biswal, DIO, NIC Jagatsinghpur, along with other committee members actively contributed to the planning, scrutiny, and execution of the entire process, ensuring transparency and accuracy at every stage. A total of 856 applications received through the portal were scrutinized and finalized for approval.

The lottery draw was successfully conducted on 2nd June 2026, and the details of the provisionally selected applicants for all 37 shops were promptly updated in the e-Abakari Portal. The DeGM, FMS personnel, and DRM of NIC Jagatsinghpur extended vital technical assistance, including internet connectivity and real-time data support throughout the event.



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JAJPUR DISTRICT

On 2nd May 2026, the lottery process for settlement of 42 IMFL (Indian Made Foreign Liquor) shops and 16 Country Liquor shops in Jajpur district was successfully conducted by the Excise Department under the chairmanship of Shri Ambar Kumar Kar, Collector & District Magistrate, Jajpur, at Gautam Buddha Sanskriti Bhawan. The process was completed peacefully, transparently, and in an orderly manner.

To ensure fairness and impartiality, the tokens were placed in a box and drawn by a blindfolded official in the presence of the applicants. The selected applicants' names were publicly announced and recorded online.

The online application process was facilitated through the State Excise Department portal, which has been developed and is being maintained by National Informatics Centre (NIC), Odisha. A total of 824 applications were received for IMFL OFF Shops. NIC, Jharsuguda played a key role in ensuring the smooth conduct of the entire process. Shri Tarani Behera, District Informatics Officer (DIO), NIC Jharsuguda, served as a member of the scrutiny committee and provided technical assistance for downloading applications, documents, scrutiny of applicant data, marking of rejected applications and forwarding accepted applications to Collector, Jharsuguda etc. During the lottery proceedings, NIC, Jharsuguda provided comprehensive technical support, including real-time display of lottery proceedings and winner details.

The winner information for each shop was entered into the portal by the NIC as per the recommendations of the committee. The entire winner-entry process was also screen-recorded and preserved for future reference, ensuring transparency and accountability. The successful conduct of the lottery process reflects the effective use of digital governance platforms and the continued support of NIC in facilitating transparent and efficient public service delivery.

KALAHANDI DISTRICT

The lottery for settlement of 29 IMFL OFF and CL Shops in Kalahandi district was successfully conducted on 29th May 2026 from 10:00 AM to 6:30 PM at Conference Hall, Collectorate Kalahandi under the chairmanship of the District Magistrate & Collector Kalahandi Shri Sachin Pawar, IAS. The entire process was supervised by the ADM Kalahandi Shri Tanmaya Kumar Darwan OAS (SAG) and the Superintendent of Excise Kalahandi Shri Ranjan Kumar Naik with active support from the Excise Department, NIC Kalahandi and the District Administration. A total of 842 applications were received and scrutinized for the notified shops before conduct of the lottery.

NIC Kalahandi played a key role in ensuring transparency and technical efficiency throughout the event. The team undertook scrutiny and finalization of applications, provided technical support for the computerized lottery process, live streamed the proceedings, simultaneously uploaded lottery results on the State Excise Portal, and maintained screen recordings of the result publication process. KANDHAMAL DISTRICT

The lottery process for the grant of India Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) "OFF" shop licenses for Kandhamal District was successfully executed on 29th May 2026, at 09:00 AM at the Zilla Parishad Conference Hall, Kandhamal. The end-to-end online application process was facilitated through the official State Excise Department portal developed and maintained by the National Informatics Centre (NIC), Odisha. A total of 204 applications were received for 15 of the 17 notified IMFL "OFF" shops. No applications were registered for the remaining 02 shops.

NIC Kandhamal provided critical technical oversight to ensure the procedural integrity of the operation. Shri Manoj Kumar Sethi, District Informatics Officer (DIO), NIC Kandhamal, served as a key member of the Scrutiny Committee. His technical responsibilities included:

- Managing the secure download of applications and supporting documentation.
- Conducting rigorous data verification and applicant scrutiny.
- Systematically forwarding verified applications to the Collector, Kandhamal, for final approval.
