Subject:- Ranking of states/UTs for land acquisition-Launch of the Land Acquisition Portal.

Will all the Additional Chief Secretaries/Principal Secretaries to Government Haryana (except Power, Urban Estates, Irrigation, Agriculture, PW(B&R), Public Health Engineering, and Industries & Commerce Department) kindly refer to the subject cited above?

In this regard it is intimated that Government of India is preparing a Land Acquisition Ranking Index under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (RFCTLARR Act, 2013) and has prepared a draft parameter for ranking of the States/UTs with regard to their performance in land acquisition cases. Therefore, they have decided ranking of States/UTs on Land Acquisition for projects under the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 from 01.01.2014 onwards and this will be a continuing process. In order to capture information on various parameters of land acquisition, required/necessary for ranking of the states/UTs an MIS has been developed by the Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development, GoI. States will feed data in the said software and submit information on land acquisition for developmental projects both where land acquisition process is completed and undergoing. Login ID and password for MIS will be shared separately on receipt of the details of the officers authorized (state level as well as district level) to make entry in the portal. A copy of D.O. No. 28012/47/2021-LRD, dated 9.12.2021 alongwith enclosures received from Joint Secretary to Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development, Department of Land Resources, New Delhi is enclosed for perusal.

2. In view of the above, departments will decide name of the nodal officer in the matter and send their particulars in the user registration form prescribed by the Government of India, MoRD to them through email on email ids shared by MoRD in their above mentioned D.O. letter dated 09.12.2021 to enable them to create said officers' login IDs and passwords.

3. It is, therefore, requested to ask the concerned officer in the matter to take immediate necessary action in the matter and send action taken report to this department as soon as possible. In case of doubt a briefing from Deputy Secretary Revenue (LR) may be obtained.

Please refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 9.11.2021, followed by D.O. letter dated 25.11.2021 (copies enclosed) and a meeting taken by Secretary, DoLR on 30.11.2021 through video conferencing regarding land acquisition ranking of States and UTs.

2. In the meeting held on 30.11.2021 with States/UTs to review preparedness and demonstration of the MIS for land acquisition ranking, it was decided that in the first phase, land acquisition under the RFCTLAAR Act, 2013 undertaken from 01.01.2014 onwards will be covered for ranking purpose and this will be a continuing process.

3. The suggestions / inputs received from the States / UTs have been considered and incorporated in the parameters for ranking.

4. I am sharing with you the link of the software ([url: larr.dolr.gov.in](http://larr.dolr.gov.in)) developed by the Department so as to enable the respective States/UTs to feed data and submit information on land acquisition for developmental projects both where land acquisition process is completed and undergoing. To facilitate data entry a guideline for steps-wise data feeding will be shared shortly. Login ID and Password for MIS will be shared separately on receipt of the details of the officers authorized (state level as well as district level) to make entry in the portal.

It is suggested that data may be entered at first source of generation of information at district level to ensure accurate and authentic entry of information on Realtime basis.

5. I would request all States/UTs to accord TOP PRIORITY as the ranking will reflect on performance of the concerned State/UT. You are requested to start preparation for data entry of all projects from 01.01.2014 under RFCTLAAR Act 2013 so that data entry of project can be completed before 15th Dec 2021 itself to enable to generate ranking status automatically.

Name and contact details of nodal officer / officers authorised (preferably a senior officer from Revenue Department) may be sent to this Department at prasd-upsc@gov.in, dinesh.kumar@nic.in or neeraj.kumar06@nic.in in the format enclosed to enable this Department to create login ID and password and for effective coordination between this Department and the State / UT..

Dear *Madam/Sir/Collague,*

Please refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 9.11.2021 followed by reminder dated 22.11.2021 (copies enclosed) regarding action on the directions given by Hon'ble Prime Minister during interaction with Secretaries of Union Ministries/ Departments on 18th September, 2021. It was *inter alia directed / suggested* that there should be ranking framework for States in giving clearances. Some incentives may be given to the States for providing timeline clearances.

2. DoLR has been entrusted with responsibility of ranking of States /UTs on Land Acquisition for projects under the RECTLARR Act 2013 from 01.01.2014 onwards. The criterion of ranking has already been shared for your comments / suggestions vide references mentioned above and it was also discussed during the National Workshop held on 16.11.2021 at New Delhi.

3. Land acquisition undertaken from 01.01.2014 onwards will be covered for ranking purpose and this will be a continuing process. Here it is highlighted that this ranking will be monitored at very high level including PMC and therefore States /UTs are expected to accord high priority to this system and also bring it to the notice of their respective Hon'ble Minister in -charge in the State /UT and Office of the Hon'ble Chief Minister.

4. In order to capture information on various parameters of land acquisition, required/necessary for ranking of the states/UTs, a MIS has been developed by the Department which is a software driven programme to submit information by respective states/UTs on land acquisition for developmental projects. It is requested that Department of Revenue of the State/UT play the role of nodal/ coordination with all concerned departments/agencies for submission of information in the MIS.

5. Now a meeting under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Department of Land Resources is scheduled on 30.11.2021 at 3.30 P.M to review preparedness and

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demonstration of the MIS for land acquisition ranking followed by another VC on 6.12.2021 at 3.30 P.M to review the 'auto-generated ranking' after feeding of data by States/UTs. Link for the VC is being shared separately. Kindly make it convenient to attend both the VCs along with your Nodal Officer(s).

6. I would request all States/UTs to accord TOP PRIORITY as the ranking will reflect on performance of the concerned State/UT. You are requested to start preparation for data entry of all projects from 01.01.2014 under RFCTLAAR Act 2013 so that data entry of project can be completed before 6th Dec 2021 itself to enable us to generate ranking status automatically




Sub: Ranking of States/UTs for land acquisition under the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.

Sir,

I am directed to say that during interaction with Secretaries of Union Ministries/Departments by Hon'ble Prime Minister, it was *inter alia* directed / suggested that land acquisition and forest clearance issues are very difficult to resolve in certain States. There should be ranking framework for States in giving clearances. Some incentives may be given to the States for providing timeline clearances.

Accordingly, Department of Land Resources is in the process of introducing / instituting a Land Acquisition Ranking Index under the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 and has prepared a draft parameter for ranking of the States/UTs with regard to their performance in land acquisition cases. The same is enclosed herewith for your comments / suggestions before it is finalized. It is requested to submit comments / suggestions by 15th November 2021.
