Dated Chandigarh, the 07th April, 2022.

Applications are invited from suitable candidates for one post of Member (having judicial background) in the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana at Panchkula from amongst following who are otherwise not ineligible or disqualified as per provisions of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for Appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 and complete the entire eligibility criteria on or before the last date of receipt of application:-

A person shall not be qualified for appointment as a Member unless he is of not less than forty years of age and possess-

An experience of atleast ten years as Presiding Officer of a District Court or of any Tribunal at equivalent level or combined service as such in the District Court and Tribunal.

The number of vacancies may increase or decrease for any reason whatsoever such as resignation or relieving of Members.

2. The candidates selected for appointment as Member of the State Commission, Haryana shall hold office for a term of four years or upto the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.
3. The selection of the Member of State Commission shall be made by the Selection Committee prescribed in Rule 6 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for Appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 made under the provisions the Consumer Protection Act, 2019.
4. Every appointment of a Member shall be subject to submission of a certificate of physical fitness signed by a Civil Surgeon or District Medical Officer to his/her medical fitness.
5. Before appointment, the selected candidate shall have to furnish an undertaking that he does not and will not have any such financial or other interest as is likely to affect prejudicially his function as such Member.

6. Every person appointed to be a Member, before entering upon his office make and subscribe an oath of office and secrecy in Form-I and Form-II.

7. A Member, before entry upon his office, declare his assets and his liabilities and other interests.

8. A person shall be disqualified for appointment as a member, if he—

- (1) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude; or
- (2) has been adjudged to be insolvent; or
- (3) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (4) has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
- (5) has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affect his functions as the member.

The selection of Member or the President shall be regulated as per the provision of Rule 4 (3) of Consumer Protection (Qualification for Appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020. Meaning thereby that the Selection of Women Member or Women President shall be dependent on the constitution of the State Commission.

9. All other terms and conditions of the appointment of Member shall be governed by the Consumer Protection Act, 2019, The Consumer Protection (Qualification for Appointment, Method of Recruitment, Procedure of Appointment, Term of Office, Resignation and Removal of the President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 and the Haryana Consumer Protection (Salary, Allowances and conditions of Service of Presidents and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2021.

10. Incomplete applications or applications not supported by requisite attested copies of documents related to different columns of application form will be rejected without assigning any reason for the same and the candidates will not be called for interview.

11. Applications complete in all respects with the application fee of Rs.2,000/- (Rs. Two thousand only) in the shape of Demand Draft only in favour of Secretary, SCDRC, Haryana payable at Panchkula, must reach in the office of the Registrar, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Haryana, Bays No.3-6, Sector-4, Panchkula-134109 latest by 29th April, 2022 upto 5.00 P.M. It is

made clear that the candidates must apply on the format given below failing which their application will not be entertained. The applications received after the last date of receipt of applications, for any reason including postal delay etc., will be rejected and the candidates will not be called for interview. The fee amount will not be refunded in any circumstances.

12. It is made clear that the candidates who do not enclose the documents alongwith their applications, their documents will not be considered later on.

13. The candidates will be called for interview whose applications are found complete in all respects, supported by requisite attested copies of documents relating to different columns of application format.
