It is requested to nominate Department functionaries/ front-line workers to work in tandem with the Nodal Officers of State Rural Development Departments and to attend the event/campaign and share an overview of National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA) / Public Distribution System (PDS), its implementation, coverage, progress made including information about implementation of ONORC which is a boon to migratory people, and other activities under under NFSA/PDS.
- 3. Since this event is also an excellent opportunity for increasing beneficiary awareness
