

**Minutes of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Chairperson, CAQM and co-chaired by Chief Secretary, Haryana on 07/11/2025 at 04:00 PM in CS Main Committee Room, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Haryana Civil Secretariat, Sector-1, Chandigarh, Haryana.**

The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Chairperson, CAQM and co-chaired by the Chief Secretary, Haryana along with officers from the concerned Departments of State of Haryana for the abatement of air pollution from key sectoral areas viz. Paddy stubble burning, dust from roads and construction, vehicular pollution, industries, thermal power plants etc. List of participants is given at Annexure-I.

At the outset of the meeting, Chairman, HSPCB Sh. Vineet Garg, IAS, welcomed the Chairperson, CAQM, Chief Secretary Haryana, Members of CAQM and all the officers of the Departments attending the meeting.

Member Secretary, CAQM highlighted the district-wise issues reported by the CPCB flying squads deputed for control of paddy stubble AFLs in the State. It was observed that very high number of CRM machines in CHCs are not operational and defunct. The Chairperson, CAQM also raised the issue of functioning of the customer hiring centers. The Commission advised the State Government to review and simplify the existing application procedure for CRM machines. The Chairperson directed all DCs to note the observed gaps and remain extra cautious for the next 10 days during the peak period of sowing. He stated that any laxity in monitoring and enforcement during the remaining season will be dealt with sternly.

Sh. Abhishek Chakravarty, NRSC, ISRO, Hyderabad made a presentation on crop residue burnt area assessment using multisource satellite data. The Chairperson, CAQM appreciated the use of technology for effective monitoring and assessment and requested DCs to participate in the ground truthing exercise and provide as much ground validation data in the next three weeks as possible.

Agriculture Department made a detailed presentation on the CRM availability in the State, subsidy passed on to the farmers, facilities available for utilization of paddy straw and State specific incentives passed on to the farmers. Presentation highlighted deterrent actions such as imposition of

environmental compensation, lodging of FIR and red entry in the agriculture record, invariably in all cases wherein AFLs were reported. Till date only 206 AFLs reported were against 888 numbers during the corresponding period last year. It was brought to the notice of the Commission that out of this large number of AFLs reported AFLs were not found on many sites during site verification. Further, State assured that Direction No. 92 will be complied with in letter and spirit and co-firing of paddy stubble biomass in brick kilns commensurate to year wise directions will be ensured.

Regarding the preparedness for the GRAP, the Chairperson, CAQM desired the intensity of inspection by HSPCB and urban local bodies to be increased. The Chairperson, CAQM raised the issue regarding the operation of MRSM and desired the same to be linked with GPS system and the details regarding the roads and timings of MRSM to be made available in public domain. He also asked HSPCB officers to verify and report the operation of such MRSMs regularly. The Chairperson, CAQM mentioned that Haryana may go for OPEX model for sweeping of roads through MRSMs at least in the metro cities like Gurugram and Faridabad with GPS tagged monitoring mechanism for such MRSMs through online portal as was being done by other cities. The Chairperson, CAQM also mentioned that a mobile van mounted with CAAQMS may be arranged for monitoring the AQI in localized areas.

The Chairperson, CAQM highlighted that the progress for legacy waste management, fresh waste management and C&D waste management is very slow in Gurugram and Faridabad.

The Chairperson, CAQM mentioned that from now onwards the non-achievement of co-firing targets in TPPs will attract imposition of environmental compensation as well as punitive action under section 14 of the CAQM Act. He expressed concerns regarding the non-achievement of targets by HPGCL and directed to achieve the co-firing targets this year unfailingly.

Regarding the transport emissions, the Chairperson, CAQM, highlighted that no progress has been made so far on the portal and policy regarding compliance of Direction No. 94. The Chief Secretary directed that

such portal and policy should be in place within 10 days. Regarding non entry of BS-III and below vehicles in the NCT Delhi with effect from 01.11.2025, Sh. Virinder Sharma, Member Technical, CAQM desired that such vehicles may be stopped at toll plaza in the jurisdiction of Haryana State to stop piling up and diversion of such vehicles from Delhi borders.

After detailed deliberations on the agenda items, decisions taken during the meeting are summarized as under:-

1. All the concerns raised by CAQM be addressed and the Directions of CAQM be complied.
2. DCs to micro-manage the deployment and operation of CRM machines, ensuring optimal availability at CHCs, especially in hotspot districts.
3. DCs to assess the availability and utilization of CRM machines to submit accurate funding proposals for central schemes. The availability of machines must be ensured well in advance before the start of the harvesting season.
4. State Agriculture Department to ensure the provision of the maximum number of balers and rakes for effective ex-situ management across the state.
5. Field officers/DCs/SSPs across all districts must remain extra vigilant for the next 10-15 days during the peak sowing period to ensure that there is no spurt in fire events.
6. DCs to analyze and map nodal officers and other functionaries with farm fire events in their jurisdiction and take necessary actions as per the extant provisions in the areas with higher fire events.
7. Co-firing of biomass based pellets in TPPs as per the targets shall be met for the year 2025-26 as HPGCL is lagging far behind the targets. Non-compliant will be imposed with EC & penal action under Section 14 of the CAQM Act.
8. The State may devise some kind of protection/insurance to industries/individuals against fire accidents/hazards in the stockpile of paddy straw bales.



9. Road redevelopment plan for the next year (2026) shall be prepared and finalized with adequate financial arrangement by the State of Haryana as per the framework issued by CAQM. Further, the plan for the year 2025 as prepared by the State shall be executed in time.
10. Intensification of inspections of all C&D projects and industries by HSPCB and Urban Local Bodies during the GRAP period to be increased and actions shall be initiated against the violators.
11. Sufficient number of MRSMs, as per the road length and as per the width of the road to be swept, shall be deployed to ensure that each road is cleaned on daily basis and plan to be submitted to CAQM within in a month.
12. Operation of MRSM need to be linked with GPS system and monitoring to be portal enabled. The details regarding the roads and timings of MRSMs to be declared in public domain. HSPCB officers to verify and report the operation of such MRSM regularly.
13. Authorities of the Haryana Transport Department to prepare and finalize the State policy/directions/portal for the aggregators, DSPs and e-commerce entities on priority to ensure the implementation of Direction No. 94.
14. Govt. Of Haryana shall ensure wide publicity for implementation of Direction No. 88 among all the stakeholders through media/ social media and other IEC activities/ hoardings & banners.
15. To comply with Direction No. 92, standard operating procedure for implementing and monitoring mechanism shall be prepared and shared within 15 days.
16. A mobile van with CAAQMS mounted on it be arranged for monitoring the air quality in the localized zones/areas and in the hotspot areas.
17. Nodal officer from concerned Departments for communication with CAQM to be appointed immediately and names and contact details of such officers shall be shared with CAQM immediately.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
