ORDER

Whereas; disciplinary proceedings under Rule 8 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment & Appeal) Rules, 1987 were initiated against Sh. Ramautar, DFSC (Retd.), vide charge-sheet Memo No. SB-I-SRS-I-2015/18065 dated 25.05.2015, in respect of alleged irregularities relating to storage and upkeep of wheat stocks during his posting in Sirsa 2013-14. The allegations against the charged officer primarily related to failure to ensure proper storage and upkeep of wheat stocks, resulting in approximately 1,478 MT of wheat not being maintained in sound and prescribed storage conditions. The value of the damaged wheat was assessed to approximately ₹1,81,67,890/-.

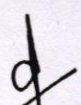
And whereas; the charged officer, in his written reply submitted, inter alia, that he joined as DFSC, Sirsa, only on 30.05.2013, whereas the wheat stock in question pertained to Rabi Marketing Season 2012-13. He further submitted that during the relevant period, four different District Food & Supplies Controllers had served at Sirsa and that the deterioration of the wheat was primarily attributable to heavy and untimely rainfall resulting in excess moisture.

And whereas; the charged officer was afforded an opportunity of personal hearing on 29.07.2026 at 12:00 noon. During the personal hearing, the officer reiterated the submissions made in his written reply and specifically submitted that the wheat stock was in sound condition at the time of his posting as DFSC, Sirsa. The charged officer further submitted that the then Inspectors had informed the department regarding the condition of the wheat vide letter dated 18.04.2014. He also submitted that his predecessor, Sh. Ram Singh, DFSC, had already informed the Headquarters/Directorate during the year 2012-13 that the wheat stock had been affected by rain, resulting in excess moisture, and that the affected wheat required early dispatch on priority basis.

After careful consideration of the material available on record (the charge-sheet, written statement, & submissions made during the personal hearing), it is found that reply of the officer is satisfactory. Hence, it would be appropriate that charge-sheet issued to Sh. Ramautar, DFSC Sirsa (Now retired) vide Memo No. SB-I-SRS-I-2015/18065 dated 25.05.2015, may be dropped.

I, order accordingly.

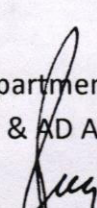
