PRESS NOTE

Panchkula, the 31st **May, 2019**: Dr. Dalip Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana stated that the election programme for the conduct of the Bye elections on 355 vacant seats viz. 317 Panches, 31 Sarpanches of Gram Panchayat and 7 Members of Panchayat Samitis has been issued today. The polling for these elections shall be held on 07.07.2019, the Election programme is as under:-

2. He further stated that according to the above mentioned programme, Nomination papers for the election to Panches and Sarpanches of Gram Panchayats shall be filed and received at the concerned Gram Panchayat Headquarter and that for the members of Panchayat Samitis at the concerned Block Headquarter by the Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer. The scrutiny of the nomination papers shall be taken up by the Returning Officer concerned. The votes for these elections shall be given by recording of votes by voting machines [Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs)]. The counting of votes for all these elections shall be held at all polling stations on the same day.

3. He further stated that a candidate filing the nomination paper for contesting the election of the seat of Panch, Sarpanch and Member Panchayat Samiti shall have to deposit an amount in Government Treasury or Sub Treasury or with the respective Returning Officer in cash, as under, as the case may be:-

Panch	Rs.100/-	Rs.40/-
Sarpanch	Rs.200/-	Rs.100/-
Member Panchayat Samiti	Rs.300/-	Rs.150/-

4. Dr. Singh further told that the directions are being issued to all the Deputy Commissioners –cum-District Election Officers to give wide publicity to the above programme by munadi in villages, issue of press notes and other handouts and also by inserting paid advertisements in the two local news papers and through electronic media, so that more and more people may come to cast their vote and elect the members of Panchayati Raj for strengthening the democracy at grass root level. NOTA (None of the above) option shall be applicable in the elections of Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayats and members of Panchayat Samities.

5. He further stated that any person whose name is not included in the voters list/electoral rolls of the concerned Gram Panchayats, may apply to the Deputy Commissioner concerned alongwith prescribed fee not later than four days from the date of publication of election programme.

6. Dr.Dalip Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana further appeals to all concerned voters to participate to elect the Members of Panchayati Raj Institutions for strengthening the democracy at grass root level.
