# PRESS NOTE <br> MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 

Chandigarh, the 23 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ May, 2022: Sh. Dhanpat Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana stated that the programme for conduct of General Elections for the seats of Presidents and Members of all wards of 28 Municipal Committees and 18 Municipal Councils has been issued on 23.05.2022 (Annexure -A). The Election programme to conduct elections of these Municipal Committees/Municipal Councils is as under:-

## 2. Model Code of Conduct

Model Code of Conduct shall come into force from today i.e.23.05.2022 in respect of these Municipal Councils/Committees. No officer/official connected with the election work shall be transferred from his/her present place of posting till the completion of election process.

## 5. Expenditure Limit

Expenditure limit for the candidates contesting election for the seat of President \& members of Municipal Committee/ Municipal Council has been revised and is fixed as follows:-

All the contesting candidates are required to maintain account of election expenditure and submit the same within 30 days from the date of declaration of election result to the Deputy Commissioner or an officer authorized by the State Election Commission, failing which the defaulting candidate shall be liable to be disqualified for 5 years.

## 6. Affidavit regarding Criminal Cases against the Candidates, if any

To bring criminal record of the contesting candidates before the general public, the State Election Commission has issued guidelines about the "Publication of Criminal antecedents". Some of the major guidelines are as under:-
(a) Candidates who have criminal cases against them- either pending or in which the candidate has been convicted, shall publish a declaration about such cases, for wide publicity, in two newspapers (at least one Hindi and one English) having wide circulation in the concerned municipal area. The declaration is required to be published (in prescribed Format C-1) at least on three different dates from the day following the last date for withdrawal of candidatures and upto two days before the date of poll.
(b) Candidates with criminal cases are also required to publish the above declaration on local TV channels or cable networks (If locally available) on three different dates during the above mentioned period and upto 48 hours ending with the hour fixed for conclusion of poll.
(c) The Returning Officer shall give a written reminder (in prescribed Format C-2) about the directions given herein for publishing declaration about the criminal cases in newspapers and local TV channels or cable networks (if locally available) for wide publicity to all candidates who have criminal cases as per the declaration in items (5) and (6) of Form 1C. The candidates shall submit copies of the newspapers in which their declaration in this regard was published to the Deputy Commissioner or an officer authorized by the State Election Commission, alongwith their account of election expenses.
(d) In the case of candidates with criminal cases set up by political parties, whether recognized parties or registered unrecognized parties, such candidates are required to declare before the Returning Officer concerned that they have informed their political party about the criminal cases against them.
(e) Recognized Political parties and registered un-recognized parties, which set up candidates with criminal cases, either pending or of past conviction, are required to publish declaration (in prescribed Format $\mathrm{C}-3$ ) giving details in this regard on their website as well as in local TV channels or cable networks (if locally available) and at least two newspapers (one Hindi and one English) having wide circulation in the municipal area concerned.
(f) Recognized Political parties and registered un-recognized parties, which set up candidates with criminal cases shall have to
submit a report to the Deputy Commissioner concerned stating that they have fulfilled the requirements of the directions, and shall enclose paper cutting containing declaration published by the party in this respect. This shall be done within 30 days of completion of election.

## 7. Direct elections for the post of President

Seats of Presidents in the Municipal Committees/Councils shall be filled up through direct elections from the territorial constituencies/wards of Municipal Committee/Municipal Council concerned. The eligible voters of the constituencies/wards of the Municipal Committees/ Municipal Councils shall thus elect their President directly by casting votes, whereas earlier these seats were being filled up from amongst the elected members of the Municipal Committee/ Municipal Council concerned. However, the seats of VicePresidents of the Municipal Committees/ Municipal Councils shall be filled up as per earlier practice i.e. through indirect election from amongst the elected members of the Municipal Committee/Municipal Council concerned.

## 8. Manpower

About 10000 polling personnel including ROs, AROs, Supervisory Staff, Presiding Officers, Polling Officers and other staff will be deployed for smooth conduct of these elections.

## 9. Police Deployment Sensitive \& Hyper Sensitive booths

Elaborate arrangements are being made for conduct of elections in a free, fair, transparent and peaceful manner. Adequate police force shall be deployed to maintain law and order at the polling stations and extra police force will be provided in sensitive and hyper sensitive areas.

## 10. EVMs

M-2 Type 4000 EVMs have been supplied in to the districts. A separate EVM shall be used for each post i.e. President and Member.

## 11. Printing of Ballot Papers

The ballot paper for President shall be of pink colour and for members it shall be of white colour. Photographs of the contesting candidates shall be got printed on the ballot papers along with other particulars to be displayed on the balloting unit of EVMs. Photograph of the candidate shall be printed in the panel and shall appear on the right side of the name in between the name and symbol of the candidate.

## 12. NOTA (None of the above)

NOTA option will be used in these elections so that voters who come to the polling stations and decide not to vote for any candidate in fray, may be able to exercise their right of not to vote while maintaining their right of secrecy. The salient features of the NOTA are as under:-
i). NOTA is to be treated as a "Fictional Electoral Candidate' while declaring the election results.
ii). If in election, all the contesting candidates individually receive lesser votes than the 'Fictional Electoral Candidate’ i.e. NOTA, then none of the contesting candidate will be declared as elected and fresh election shall be held for that post.
iii). In case contesting candidate and the 'Fictional Electoral Candidate' i.e. NOTA receive equal valid votes; then the contesting candidate (not NOTA) shall be declared as elected.
iv). Fresh election will start from nomination stage itself.
v). No candidate shall be eligible to file his nomination if he was a contesting candidate in first election in which his votes were less than 'Fictional Electoral Candidate' i.e. NOTA.
vi). If in re-election, NOTA again get highest votes, then no further election shall be held and contesting candidate with highest votes (excluding NOTA) shall be declared as elected.

## 13. Electoral Roll/Voters List

State Election Commission has prepared electoral rolls of the Municipal Committees/ Municipal Councils on the basis of Vidhan Sabha electoral rolls published by the Election Commission of India on 05.01.2022 with reference
to $1^{\text {st }}$ January, 2022 as qualifying date. However, if any person whose name is not included in the ward wise electoral rolls of the Municipal Committee/Council concerned, but his/her name exists in the relevant part of the electoral roll of the State Legislative Assembly constituency, he/she may apply (in Form "A") to the Returning Officer for inclusion of his/her name in the electoral rolls of municipality till the last date of filing of nomination. Returning Officer shall be the competent authority for inclusion of name in the electoral roll from the issuance of election programme till the last date of filing of nomination. The decision taken by the Returning Officer on such applications shall be final. If the name of any applicant has been included in the electoral roll of any ward of the concerned Municipal Committee/Council and he/she intends to contest the election, he/she shall be allowed to file his/her nomination. No amendment, transposition or deletion of any entry in the electoral roll shall be made and no direction for inclusion of a name in the electoral roll of any ward shall be given, after the last date for filing of nominations for an election in that Municipal Committee/ Municipal Council.

## 14. Appointment of Election Observers (General/Expenditure and Police)

For conduct of elections in a free, fair, transparent and peaceful manner, the State Election Commission shall appoint senior IAS/HCS Officers as Election Observers, senior IPS/HPS officers as Police Observers for the maintenance of law and order and senior officers of Excise and Taxation Department as Expenditure Observers in the Municipal Committees/Councils concerned. These Observers shall keep reporting to the State Election Commission from time to time.

## 15. Voters Awareness Programme

To make voters aware, the State Election Commission has hosted video clips on the website of the State Election Commission. The Commission in this respect shall also release advertisements in the local newspapers and electronic media i.e. radio and T.V. channels, from time to time.

## 16. COVID-19 Pandemic Protocol

The State Election Commission shall issue guidelines/directions to the district administration to follow COVID-19 related protocol during elections meticulously.

## 17. Poll Percentage of the last General Election

Municipal Committee/Municipal Council wise details of total number of wards, number of polling booths, seats/wards of President/members reserved for Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Castes (Women) \& Women and total number of voters is given at Annexure-C.

## 18. Appeal

An appeal is issued to the voters of these Municipal Councils/Committees in the State to participate in these elections to elect their representatives without any bias of caste/religion and without any fear or favour for strengthening democracy at the grass root level.
