General Elections of Panchayati Raj Institutions- Maintenance of Law & Order to Ensure Free and Fair elections.

Sir,

I have been directed to refer to the above subject and to say that the State Election Commission, Haryana has issued notification for conduct of general elections for three tiers of Panchayati Raj Institutions in 4 districts, namely; Faridabad, Fatehabad, Hisar and Palwal vide Notification No.SEC/4E-II/2022/4332, dated 28.10.2022(copy enclosed). As per election schedule, nomination papers shall be presented from 05.11.2022 to 11.11.2022 and poll shall be held on 22.11.2022 and 25.11.2022. Re-poll, if any, required, shall be held on 25.11.2022 and 27.11.2022 and counting of votes in respect of Panches and Sarpanches shall be held immediately after the close of poll at the polling stations of the Gram Panchayat concerned. Counting for election of Members of 143 Panchayat Samitis and 22 Zila Parishads shall be held on 27.11.2022 at the place(s) specified by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer (Panchayat) concerned and result shall be declared immediately after the completion of counting.

- 2. I have further been directed to say that with a view to ensure conduct of elections of the Panchayati Raj Institutions in a transparent, peaceful, free and fair manner, the State Election Commission, Haryana has decided that steps should be taken for effective enforcement of certain measures in the sensitive areas, where, election is scheduled to be held on 22.11.2022 and 25.11.2022. In this connection, specific measures enunciated by the State Election Commission are detailed hereunder and it is requested that the same may kindly be got enforced both in letter and spirit.
- (I) The police should be asked to be vigilant and start mopping up operation of the areas infested with known goondas and bad elements about 10 days prior to the poll. During such mopping operation, special attention should be paid to unearth and seize unlicensed arms and ammunition right from now.
- (II) No new arms licenses should be issued with effect from 28.10.2022 date on which the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with the

announcement of election programme till the announcement of election results.

- (III)An order must be issued prohibiting carrying of any fire arms and weapons with effect from 28.10.2022. Further effective steps may also be taken to unearth un-licensed weapons and seize the same.
- (IV) Arrangement must be made for deployment of adequate number of police personnel at each polling station and near each polling station and also in sensitive areas.
- Adequate number of wireless sets must be provided to improve (V) communication for meeting any law and order problem of emergent
- Strict vigil may be kept over movement of un-desirable elements and (VI) vigorous checks may be carried out to prevent men and vehicles moving with arms and ammunition.
- Thorough checking of Lorries, trucks and other vehicles must be carried out for three days before poll and on the poll day etc. to ensure that no undesirable elements or arms ammunition are infiltrated into and around the polling areas.
- (VIII) Restriction on movement of vehicles on poll days must be imposed and instructions may be issued to regulate vehicular traffic and plying of vehicles on the poll day.
- (IX)Sale and consumption of liquor should be stopped one day before the poll, on poll day or and the day on which counting of votes is to be taken, otherwise penal action should be taken. The Excise and Taxation Department is also being instructed to issue necessary orders in this regard.
- 3. I have further been directed to request you to issue necessary orders and instructions with regard to the points mentioned above to the concerned offices immediately under intimation to the State Election Commission.
