PREFACE



Free and fair elections are the foundation of a healthy democracy. Parts IX and IXA of the Constitution of India brought into force by the 73rd and the 74th Constitutional amendments, deal with matters relating to the constitution, composition and the functional ambit of the Panchayats and Municipalities respectively.

By virtue of the Articles 243K and 243ZA, the responsibility for superintendence, direction and control of the preparation of electoral rolls for, and the conduct of elections to, the Panchayats and Municipalities have been vested in the State Election Commission. Subject to the provisions of the Constitution, the Legislature of a State may, by law, make provisions with respect to all matters relating to, or in connection with elections to such local bodies.

The State Election Commission is a constitutional body responsible for the conduct and supervision of elections to the Local Bodies (Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation) in the State of Haryana. We are also required to bring about the work of Election Commission in a transparent manner for all, interested to see it including many progressive groups and individuals who have contributed their time, energy and ideas in order to make the 3rd General Elections of Municipal Councils/committees/Corporation a great success, in all respects.

I am pleased to present this Election Report for the 3rd General Elections to the Local Bodies (Municipal Councils/committees/ Corporation) and some important achievements attained by the State Election Commission of Haryana in this regard. This narrative report by the State Election Commission, Haryana gives you a comprehensive account of election events in the relevant period. The present State Election Commission has made some major efforts in various directions for improving the

system and has taken numerous initiatives to enhance the capability of this Commission to conduct free, fair and peaceful elections in the State of Haryana. This time State Election Commission has completed this gigantic task and stupendous work within a lesser amount of budget by making a saving of about one crore rupees of public money/budget for the conduct of 3rd General Elections of Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies. This has been brought out in detail in the different chapters of the report. The process of saving public money also continues even after the elections are over and also follow up action to continue for electoral reforms including improvements in the existing laws and rules related to the elections at grass root level by initiating dialogue with the State Government. It is also heartening to see the enthusiasm shown by number of officers and officials working round the clock to complete this process of all elections within a short period of 31 days, only.

I would like to put on record my appreciation for assistance rendered for successful organization of the third General Elections by all the officers and staff of the State Election Commission as well as all the Deputy Commissioners, Sub-Divisional Magistrates, City Magistrates, and other supporting staff of field offices. I have issued them appreciation letters with a copy to Chief Secretary's office with a request that appreciation letters be placed in their service record, also.

I hope that the present report will prove a valuable asset for this Commission and the field offices specially Deputy Commissioners, Revising Authorities, Policy Planners, Scholars and other organizations, as some guidelines with minute details have been provided in the various chapters of this report.

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Chapter-1

STATE ELECTION COMMISSION, HARYANA

The State Election Commission, which is a creation of the Constitution (Seventy Third and Seventy fourth) Amendment Acts, 1992, was constituted in the State of Haryana w.e.f. 18th November, 1993 vide the State Government's Notification No.SO.101/Const.Art.243A/243ZA/93.

The provisions relating to the status and powers of the State Election Commission in Article 243K and 243ZA are analogous to the powers and status of the Election Commission of India provided under Article 324 (1) of the Constitution of India. The only difference in these two provisions is that the State Election Commission has been entrusted with the responsibilities for the preparation of the electoral rolls for, and the conduct of, all elections to the Panchayati Raj Institutions and Municipalities under Articles 243K and 243ZA; and the Election Commission of India has been assigned the responsibility for the preparation of electoral rolls for, and the conduct of, all elections to Parliament and to the Legislatures of every State and of elections to the offices of President and Vice President of India. In order to ensure that the State Election Commission functions as an **independent Constitutional body** outside the executive to enable it to conduct the elections to the Panchayats and Municipalities in a free and fair manner, the concept of independence has been made far explicit in the provisions of Article 243K (2) which provides that the State Election Commissioner shall not be removed from his office except in the like manner and on the like grounds as the Judge of a High Court and the Conditions of Service of the State Election Commissioner shall not be varied to his disadvantage after his appointment. The State Election Commission, unlike the Election Commission of India, is a Commission headed by the State Election Commissioner, who is appointed by the Governor of the State under

clause (2) of Article 243K of the Constitution of India. Clause (3) of Article 243K explicitly provides that the Governor of the State shall, when so requested by the State Election Commission, make available to the State Election Commission such staff as may be necessary for the discharge of functions conferred on the State Election Commission by clause (1).

In pursuance of the above Constitutional provisions, the Legislature of the State of Haryana has also, in the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, made provisions in this regard in consonance with the provisions of Article 243K of the Constitution of India. Section 212 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 provides the powers and responsibilities of the State Election Commission, which are identical to the provisions made in Article 243K of the Constitution of India. Similar provisions have been made in Section-3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 for the conduct of elections to the Municipal Committees and Municipal Councils and in Section-9 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 for the conduct of elections to the Municipal Corporation in the State.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in clause (2) of Article 243K, the State Government has prescribed the conditions of service and tenure of the office of the State Election Commissioner in "the State Election Commissioner (Conditions of Service) Rules, 1994" which are in consonance with the provisions contained in clause (2) of Article 243K. The State Election Commissioner has been defined as the State Election Commissioner appointed under clause (1) of Article 243K of the Constitution of India, meaning thereby that the State Election Commissioner shall be appointed by the Governor of the State. The qualifications for the State Election Commissioner has been prescribed as that of a person who is or has been a Judge of a High Court, or a person who has served the Government in the rank of Commissioner for a minimum period of five years or is serving the State Government in a higher rank namely Financial

Commissioner. The minimum age for the State Election Commissioner has been prescribed as 55 years. The tenure of the State Election Commissioner has been prescribed as five years from the date he assumes office subject to that where the State Election Commissioner attains the age of sixty five years before the expiry of the said term of five years, he shall vacate his office on the date on which he attains the said age. Provided further that the State Election Commissioner may, at any time, by writing under his hand addressed to the Governor, resign his office. A person, who on the date of his appointment as State Election Commissioner was in the service of the Central or State Government, shall be deemed to have retired from such service with effect from the date of his appointment as State Election Commissioner. The State Election Commissioner is entitled to the salary equal to the salary of the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana subject to the condition that if a person who immediately before the date of assuming office as the State Election Commissioner was in receipt of, or, being eligible so to do, had opted to draw a pension in respect of any previous service under the Government of India or under the State Government or any other service, his salary in respect of service as the State Election Commissioner shall be reduced (a) by the amount of that pension, (b) by the amount of the commuted value in respect of previous if he had, before assuming office, received, in lieu of a portion of the pension due to him. The State Election Commissioner shall be entitled to travelling allowance, provision of rent free accommodation, conveyance facilities, medical facilities, leave and such other conditions of service as were applicable to him at the time of retirement or at the time of his appointment as State Election Commissioner, so far as may be apply to the State Election Commissioner. The Governor of the State is vested with the power to grant or refuse leave to the State Election Commissioner and to revoke or curtail leave granted to him. On ceasing to hold office, the State Election Commissioner, shall not be eligible for any further appointment under the Government. A person, if he is of unsound

mind or if he is an un-discharged insolvent or if he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, shall be disqualified for being appointed or for being as the State Election Commissioner.

The State Election Commissioner, Haryana has been given the status equivalent to the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana under Article 24 of the State Order of Precedence issued vide Government Notification No.50/215/99-5PP dated 25th May, 2000.

The State Election Commissioner, Haryana has also been delegated all the financial and administrative powers available to the Administrative Secretary to Government, Haryana, in so far as the work relating to the State Election Commission, Haryana, is concerned. These powers have been delegated by the State Government vide orders issued under No.20/18/94-4(2P)(i)/(ii), dated 28.3.1995. Despite this, the instructions relating to ban on purchase of vehicles, recruitment and other such restrictions for the Government departments are also made applicable to the State Election Commission.

INCUMBANCY POSITION OF STATE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

Sh.J.K.Duggal, an IAS officer of 1963 batch of Haryana Cadre was appointed the first State Election Commissioner, who joined on 15.7.1994 and continued as such till the completion of his tenure on 14.7.1999. During his tenure, the First General Elections to Urban Local Bodies were conducted in the year 1994.

Sh.T.D.Jogapl, an IAS (Retd.) officer of 1968 batch of Haryana Cadre became the next State Election Commissioner on 14.7.1999 and continued till the completion of his tenure on 14.07.2004. During his tenure, the Second General Elections to Urban Local Bodies were held in the year 2000, 2003 & 2004.

Sh.Chander Singh, an IAS officer of 1973 batch of Haryana Cadre joined as the third State Election Commissioner on 14.09.2004 and is continuing as such.

During his tenure, the Third General Elections to the Urban Local Bodies were held in April & August 2005 successfully.

Ever since its inception, the State Election Commission is functioning in a rented building in SCO No.16-17, Sector 20-D, Chandigarh. Besides the State Election Commissioner, the following officers/officials are working in the Commission against the sanctioned post(s) mentioned against their names.

Chapter-2

Electoral Rolls

PROGRAMME FOR PREPARATION OF ELECTORAL ROLLS

The provisions relating to the preparation of electoral rolls for each constituency of Committee are contained in Rules 3 to 17 in Part –II of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 which provide that the Electoral rolls shall be prepared by the Deputy Commissioner under the superintendence, direction and control of the State Election Commissioner, Haryana in accordance with these rules.

First Notification dated 28.09.2004

The State Election Commission, Haryana issued programme for preparation of electoral rolls vide its notification No.SEC/2ME/2004/10036, dated 28/09/2004 under Clause (1) of Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India read with Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and Rules 4 to 11 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978, in all the wards of the 20 Municipal Councils and 27 Municipal Committees intensively in the State on the basis of the draft Assembly Rolls finally published on 23.02.2004 w.r.t. 1st January, 2004 as the qualifying date. The final publication of the electoral rolls was done on 15/12/2004. The programme for the conduct of third Municipal General Election had to be issued by the Commission by 31.12.2004.

Stay Granted by High Court

However, in the meanwhile, the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court had stayed the operation of the Government Notification dated 07.12.2004 with regard to the amendment in Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973.

Second Notification

Consequent upon the stay granted by the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, the matter was reconsidered by the State Election Commission and it was

decided that an opportunity be given to the eligible persons whose names could not be included in the **Municipal rolls of the 20 Municipal Councils and 27 Municipal Committees**, to file application for inclusion of their names in the Municipal rolls of these municipalities. The State Election Commission in exercise of the powers conferred on it under clause (1) of article 243ZA of the Constitution of India read with Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and sub-rule (1) of Rule 12 and Rule 14 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978, had issued the programme to **prepare addenda (meaning thereby additions) to the existing electoral rolls of all the wards of 47 Municipal Councils and Committees** were finally published on 15.12.2004. Supplementary electoral rolls with reference to 1st January, 2005 as qualifying date were also prepared vide notification No. SEC/2ME/2005/16165, dated 24.01.2005. As per this programme the electoral rolls were finally published on 16/02/2005.

Publication of electoral rolls of Municipal Council Kaithal and Bhiwani

The third General Elections to Municipal Councils, Kaithal and Bhiwani were held in the month of August, 2005. The State Election Commission issued programme for preparation of electoral rolls vide its notification No. SEC/2ME/2005/3567, dated 02/05/2005, under Clause (1) of Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India read with Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and Rules 4 to 11 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978, in all the wards of Municipal Councils Kaithal and Bhiwani summarily on the basis of Assembly electoral rolls finally published on 03.01.2005 w.r.t. 1st January, 2005 as the qualifying date. As per this programme the electoral rolls were finally published on 30/06/2005.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATION FARIDABAD

The State Govt. Haryana (Urban Development Deptt.) vide its notification No. 15/3/2005-3C2, dated 16/02/2005 had determined the delimitation of 35

wards of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad. The State Election Commission in exercise of the powers conferred on it under clause (1) of Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India read with Section 9 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994, had issued the programme for preparation of electoral rolls of all the wards of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad summarily on the basis of Assembly Electoral Rolls published on 3.1.2005 with reference to 1st January, 2005 as qualifying date, vide its notification No. SEC/2ME/2005/16981, dated 16.02.2005. As per this programme the electoral rolls were finally published on 31/03/2005.

Assignment of job of printing of voters' lists to Printing Presses

The job for the printing of electoral rolls was assigned to the printing presses approved by the Commission at a competitive rate which was much less than the cost charged for the same job in previous General Elections.

CHAPTER-3

THIRD GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS, 2005

The State Election Commission, Haryana, started functioning in the right earnest to fulfill its constitutional obligations to conduct 3rd Municipal General Elections in the State. However, the function of delimitation of constituencies and reservation of seats and offices of Chairpersons of Municipal Councils and Committees have not been assigned to the State Election Commission, rather, the Government authorities who have been assigned the work of delimitation of constituencies and reservation of seats and offices of chairpersons of local bodies did this job at their own level. However, the Commission pursued the matter with the Government for expeditious completion of work relating to delimitation and reservation of wards. Thereafter, the State Election Commission undertook various steps for the conduct of Elections of Municipal Institutions in the State of Haryana and issued Election Programme vide its Notification No. SEC/1ME/2005/18000, dated 15/03/2005 for 20 Municipal Councils and 27 Municipal Committees as per details given in this report.

Meetings with District Authorities

The State Election Commissioner, immediately after the issuance of election programme, held meetings with the Divisional Commissioners as well as Deputy Commissioners to take a stock of the poll arrangements made by the District Authorities.

Rehearsal/Training of Polling Staff

Rehearsal/training was also got conducted at the District Headquarters. All the Deputy Commissioners and other District officers connected with the election work were briefed about the election process.

Coordination

The District Authorities were advised to remain in touch with the State Election Commission to sort out any problem relating to the conduct of elections and

keep a proper coordination with the officers of the Commission, who were appointed Nodal Officers for this purpose.

Visit to Printing Presses

State Election Commissioner also took a personal initiative to visit Printing presses at their respective locations with a view to assess and ensure that these presses were having the required infrastructure and technical capability and were in a position to successfully complete the assigned job regarding printing of electoral rolls for the Third Municipal General Elections. For this purpose, a proper liaison was also kept by the State Election Commissioner with the District Authorities to keep himself abreast with the day-to-day development of election related work. Staff of the State Election Commission was also deputed to the Printing Presses from time to time to supervise and check the progress of the printing of electoral rolls and ballot papers.

The elections were held on 16.04.2005.

- 4) Date by which information shall be furnished by the candidate in the format prescribed, to the concerned Returning Officer that he is not suffering from any disqualification. 29/03/2005 (Tuesday) Before 10.00 A.M.
- 5) Date on which the nomination papers shall be scrutinized under Rule 19 (2) (iii). 29/03/2005 (Tuesday)
- 6) Last date for making application for the revision of order of the authority scrutinizing the nomination papers to the Deputy Commissioner under Rule 19(2)(iv). 01/04/2005 (Friday)

- (7) Last date by which the revision applications filed under Rule 19(2)(iv) shall be decided by the Deputy Commissioner under Rule 19(2)(v). 04/04/2005 (Monday)
- (8) Last date for withdrawal of candidature by a candidate under Rule 19(2)(vi). 05/04/2005 (Tuesday) between(11.00 AM and 03.00 PM)
- (9) Date on which the list of contesting candidates shall be posted under Rule 19(2)(vii). 05/04/2005 (Tuesday)
- (10) Date on which list of polling stations shall be posted under Rule 19(2)(viii). 05/04/2005 (Tuesday)
- (11) Date on which the Poll, if any, shall be held under Rule 19(2)(ix). 16/04/2005 (Saturday)
- (12) Timing of the Poll. Between 8.00 AM and 04.00 PM
- (13) Date, Time and place on which the votes polled shall be counted. Immediately after the polling is closed, at the polling station itself on the same day.
- (14) Date on which the election Result would be declared. Immediately after the account of ballot papers received from the Presiding Officers of the Polling Stations of the constituency (Ward) is consolidated by the Returning Officer.

POLLING STATIONS AND POLLING PERSONNELS

For these elections to Municipal Councils and Committees 2652 polling stations were set-up and 13434 polling personnels were appointed. For the election of

Municipal Corporation, Faridabad 729 polling stations were set-up and a total number of 3192 polling personnels were appointed. The polling was peaceful by and large.

COUNTING OF VOTES

The counting of votes for the office of members of Municipal Councils and Committees was started at all the polling stations immediately after the close of poll on the same day. The counting of votes for members of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad was started at the counting centers specified by the Deputy Commissioners, Faridabad immediately after the close of poll on the same day

Observers

The State Election Commission appointed Senior officers of the State Government as Election Observers (General) and also appointed officers not below the rank of ETO as Observers (Expenditure) from the Excise and Taxation Department. All the Observers appointed by the State Election Commission were to ensure that elections in all the wards were conducted in a free and fair manner without any favour and fear. The Observers (Expenditure) were to observe that no candidate should exceed the expenditure limits prescribed by the State election Commission. The Commission observed that Observers performed their duties diligently. No violation of election rules and expenditure limit by the candidates was reported to the Commission.

Deployment of Police Force

In order to maintain law & order, about 15586 Police Personnel were put on election duty. To keep an overall check on the poll process, as many as 49 officers were appointed as Returning Officers for the election of Municipal Councils and Committees and one officer was also appointed as Returning Officer for the election of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad. The polling started at 8.00A.M. and concluded at 4.00P.M. The overall poll percentage in the State was 66.53 for Municipal Councils, 81.11 for Committees and 49.11 for Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

Chapter-4

NOMINATION

Rule 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 27 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 deals with supply, presentation, notice, deposit and scrutiny of nomination papers. It also provides that any person may be nominated as candidate for the election to fill the seat if he is qualified to be elected under the provisions of these Rules/Act.

During the Third Municipal General Elections, the nomination papers completed in all respects, for the offices of Members of Municipal Council/Committee/ Corporation were received **at the office of concerned Municipalities or at the office of concerned Returning Officer.**

The details regarding presentation of nomination papers, notice of nomination, time and place for scrutiny of nomination papers under rules 20 of the Haryana Municipal Elections Rules, 1978 in respect of Municipal Committee and Councils and under Rule 21 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Elections Rules, 1994 in respect of Municipal Corporation had already been discussed in the First Election Report published in the year 2004.

Some analysis about the percentage of persons elected Un-opposed, average number of nomination received, accepted, contesting candidates to the total number of such offices, during the 3rd Municipal General Elections has also been made Council-wise/Committee-wise, the detail of which are given in Annexure 6 to 8 and analysis of which is as under:-

Municipal Committees

Against the 421 seats of Member of Municipal Committees where the 3rd Municipal General Elections were held in the State, total 2719 nominations papers were received i.e. an average of 6.46% nomination papers received against one seat of Member. The highest average of nomination received is 9.87 of Municipal Committee,

Sohna of District Gurgaon and lowest average is 4.47 of Municipal Committee, Hodal of District Faridabad.

A total 1745 nomination papers were accepted from the total of 2719 nomination papers i.e. an average of 4.37% nomination papers were accepted against one seat of Member.

Out of the total 421 seats of Member of Municipal Committee, 22 were elected unopposed i.e. 5.3% members were elected unopposed. The highest average of the Members elected unopposed is 23.08% of Municipal Committee Firozpur Jhirka and lowest is 5.88% of Municipal Committees, Ratia, Hodal and Barwala.

Municipal Councils

Against the 638 seats of Member of Municipal Councils where the 3rd Municipal General Elections were held in the State, total 4716 nomination papers were received i.e. average 7.39 nomination papers received against one seat of Member. The highest average of nomination received is 11 of Municipal Council, Hisar and lowest average is 4.48 of Municipal Council, Ambala Sadar of Ambala District.

A total 3382 nomination papers were accepted from the total of 4716 nomination papers i.e. an average of 5.54% nomination papers were accepted against one seat of Member.

Out of the total 638 seats of Member of Municipal Councils, 20 were elected unopposed i.e. 3.13% members were elected unopposed. The highest average of the Members elected Unopposed is 14.29% of Municipal Council, Tohana and lowest is 3.23% of Municipal Councils, Karnal, Rewari and Jagadhari.

Municipal Corporation

Against the 35 seats of Member of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad where the 3rd Municipal General Elections were held in the State, total 616 nominations papers were received i.e. average 17.60 nomination papers received against one seat of Member. The highest number of nomination received is 39 of Ward No. 6 and lowest number is 6 of Ward Nos. 12, 23 & 27 of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad.

A total 519 nomination papers were accepted from the total of 616 nomination papers i.e. an average of 14.83 nomination papers were accepted against one seat of Member of Municipal Corporation.

Chapter-5

POLITICAL PARTIES AND SYMBOLS

The State Election Commission notified the list of symbols for election to Members of Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation vide notification No.SEC/2ME/2005/18361, dated 16.03.2005, in supersession of its earlier notification issued on 27.09.2004.

The Haryana Municipal Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1996 which was issued by the State Election Commission vide notification dated 14.5.1996, provides that the election to the office of Members of Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation may be contested on party basis, on the last date of withdrawal of nominations, the symbols (from the list notified by the Commission) shall be allotted to the contesting candidates. As per the above notification the candidates set up by the political parties for the elections to Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation were allotted the symbols reserved for the Political Party. However, there was a little response from the Political Parties to contest the Municipal General Elections, 2005. The Bhartiya Janata Party, Bahujan Samaj Party and Communist Party of India (Marxist) had set-up 127, 27 and 1 candidates respectively in these elections, only 22 candidates set-up by the Bhartiya Janata Party has been elected.

Chapter-6

BALLOT PAPERS AND BALLOT BOXES

Ballot Papers

Rule 36 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 provides that every ballot paper shall have a counter foil attached thereto, and the said ballot paper and the counter foil shall be in such form, and the particulars therein shall be in Hindi and such other language as the State Election Commissioner, Haryana may direct. The Commission had issued instructions for printing of ballot papers providing therein the specifications about size and form of the ballot paper.

Third Municipal General Elections-2005

For the Third Municipal General Elections held in April, 2005, it was decided that the ballot papers for the elections to the offices of Members of Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation shall also be got printed from the Printing & Stationery Department. The State Election Commission pointed out that as per tender invited from the various printing Presses, the ballot Papers of Panchayat General Elections, the Commission had fixed the printing rate of 46.5 paisa per ballot paper inclusive the cost of paper. The Commission also clarified that although the Commission had received the printing rate of 46.5 paisa per ballot paper inclusive the cost of paper from the private presses, however, the State Election Commission agreed to except the rate i.e. 49 paisa per ballot paper for Municipal Committee, 43 paisa per ballot paper for Municipal Council and 59 paisa for Municipal Corporation exclusive the cost of paper of Printing & Stationery Department, Haryana being a Government Department for printing of ballot papers for Third Municipal General Elections, 2005. It was also clarified that the payment will be made only on the above quoted rates and no extra charges if any will be paid for printing of ballot papers. In this way, during the Third General Elections, 2005 of Panchayati Raj Institutions and Urban Local Bodies

huge saving was achieved in comparison to the expenditure incurred on the printing of ballot papers and other expenses during the Second General Elections, 2000.

During the 3rd Municipal General Elections, 2005 a total number of 32,55,465 ballot papers (21,09,286 of Municipal Councils, 4,99,359 of Municipal Committees, 6,46,820 of Municipal Corporation) were got printed from the Printing & Stationery Department, Haryana.

Ballot Boxes

Rule 35 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 provides that every ballot box shall be of such design as may be approved by the State Election Commission, Haryana. No independent and separate design of ballot box was made by the State Election Commission and the ballot boxes used for the Assembly and Parliamentary elections, were used in the Municipal elections as well. The Commission had already purchased 1500 ballot boxes for use in the elections. Since a very large number of ballot boxes were required to be used for the Third Municipal General Elections, the ballot boxes were also taken from the Election Department, Haryana on rent basis.

MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

In exercise of powers conferred under Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India, the State Election Commission, issued Model Code of Conduct for elections to the Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation to ensure free, fair and peaceful elections. The Model Code of Conduct was made applicable to all the political parties, contesting candidates, Ministers, employees of the State Government and Local Bodies and other public servants related to the Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation. The Model Code of Conduct was enforced from the date of issue of the notification for the elections till the completion of the election process.

Ban on Sale of Liquor

As per the provisions of the Model Code of Conduct, the campaigning was stopped 48 hours before the hours fixed for the close of poll. The State Election Commission, requested the Financial Commissioner & Secretary to Government, Haryana, Prohibition and Excise & Taxation Department to notify '**dry days**' at or around the areas where the Municipal elections were to be held. The period of dry days declared and notified included the period of one day before the poll day and the day immediately, thereafter i.e., the polling and counting day. In compliance with the instructions issued by the State Election Commission, the Financial Commissioner & Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Prohibition and Excise & Taxation Department also issued directions to the field offices that: -

- (i) no liquor shops, hotels, restaurants, clubs and other establishment's selling/serving liquor should be permitted to sell and serve liquor on the aforesaid days.
- (ii) no proprietary clubs, Star Hotels, restaurants etc. and hotels run by anyone even if they are issued different categories of licenses for possessions and supply of liquor, should be permitted to serve liquors on these days.

- (iii) the storage of liquors by individuals shall be curtailed during the above period and the restrictions provided in the Excise Law on the storage in unlicensed premises should be vigorously enforced.
- (iv) Steps should also be taken to prohibit sale of liquor in adjoining areas where elections were held, so that there were no chances of clandestine movement of liquor from those areas where the restrictions were not in operation.

Declaration of Holiday

In compliance with the proposal made by the State Election Commission vide letter Nos.SEC/1ME/2005/18249, dated 15.03.2005 and No.SEC/ME/2005/6859, dated 18.07.2005 in respect of elections to Municipal Councils/Committees and vide letter No. SEC/1ME/2005/20666, dated 29.3.2005 in respect of elections to Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana also declared dates of Polls as **Holidays under Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881**, at the places where the polls were scheduled to be held, so that the workers engaged in various factories and commercial establishments located in the above areas could exercise their right to franchise.

Ban on Transfer

Further in view of the suggestions made to the Chief Secretary, Haryana by the State Election Commission, the State Government also issued orders imposing **ban on transfer** of officers and officials connected with the conduct of elections to the Municipal Councils/Committees/Corporation during the period when the Model Code of Conduct was in force.

Ban on release of grants and laying foundation stones etc.

In compliance with the instructions issued by the Commission, the State Government also issued instructions that during the period when the Model Code of Conduct is in force, the Ministers **will not announce any grant** from the Government funds and **no foundation stone will be laid down** for any **new project or scheme**.

Misuse of Vehicle

Instructions were also issued by the State Election Commission to all the Deputy Commissioners to prevent **misuse of vehicles** on the poll day.

Miscellaneous

Instructions were also issued to the Deputy Commissioners about the use of Electoral Photo Identity Cards for identification of voters during polling, to hold meetings with the representatives of the Political Parties, deployment of police force at the counting centers and to review law and order situation during the elections.

Chapter- 8

OBSERVERS

In exercise of powers conferred on him under Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India, the Commission had appointed Senior IAS Officers of the rank of Joint Secretary as Election Observer and Senior officers of the rank of Excise & Taxation Officer of the Excise and Taxation Department as Expenditure Observers for the Third Municipal General Elections held in April/August, 2005.

The Election Observers were asked to oversee the election process in the districts allotted to them and the Expenditure Observer, in particular, were assigned the responsibility to observe that the expenditure incurred by the contesting candidates for the election is as per the limits prescribed by the Commission.

Detailed instructions were issued to all the Deputy Commissioners in the State to ensure suitable accommodation in the Government Rest Houses or Circuit Houses, Government vehicles, telephone facilities, police escorts and security guards to the Observers appointed in their respective Districts. The Deputy Commissioners were also asked that a senior Revenue Officer be deputed to accompany each Observer, during their visit to the Polling Stations.

The Election Observers were asked to paste stickers on their vehicles clearly showing that the vehicle was being used by the Election Observer. The Observers were also advised that they should meet the representatives of the recognized political parties, the candidates and also listen to their grievances and look into the complaints received from the candidates and general public. They were also advised to give special attention to the sensitive polling stations and in the cases of threats to the voters, especially to the people belonging to the weaker sections. The Expenditure Observers were instructed to ensure that the contesting candidates should maintain day-to-day accounts of expenditure incurred by them from the last date of

withdrawal onwards. They were also asked to see that all expenses incurred by the contesting candidates or their authorized election agents, on petrol, postage, printing of pamphlets, election campaign material, advertisements in the newspapers, expenditure on stationery items and any other such expenses, which may be directly or indirectly related with the election, are taken into account.

The following IAS Officers were appointed as Election Observers and Officers of the Excise and Taxation Department appointed as Expenditure Observers for the Third General Elections held in April, 2005:-

As specified in the notification issued by the Commission the votes were polled between 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on the above said date and overall poll percentage in the State was 70% to 75%. Except one minor incident, the poll remained peaceful.

Repoll

Since the poll process was vitiated at polling booth No.13 & 15 of Ward No.3 of Municipal Council, Rohtak, the State Election Commission ordered for repoll at the above said polling booth and repoll was held on 18.04.2005.

Municipal Council, Kaithal & Bhiwani

The State Election Commission, vide its Notification No. SEC/1ME/2005/6835, dated 18.07.2005, issued the election programme for holding elections in all the wards of Municipal Council, Kaithal & Bhiwani and the poll was held on 21.08.2005 from 8.00 A.m. to 4.00 P.M. peacefully.

Municipal Corporation, Faridabad

The State Election Commission vide its Notification No. SEC/1ME/2005/20650, dated 29.03.2005, issued the election programme for holding elections in all the wards of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, District Faridabad. According to the election schedule, the poll was held on 30.04.2005 peacefully.

Chapter-10

COUNTING OF VOTES

The detailed instructions for the counting of votes have been provided in the booklets titled as "**Guidelines for the Presiding Officers**" and "**Instructions for the Returning Officers/Assistant Returning Officers**".

The counting of votes being one of the most important aspects in the process of election, in the rehearsal of Polling Staff, it was stressed upon the Returning Officers, Presiding Officers and Polling Officers that they should strictly adhere to the instructions provided in the instructions booklet supplied to them. During the rehearsals, the necessary forms and dummy ballot papers were also displayed to explain them about the various steps they should take during the counting of votes, specially about different types of markings on the ballot papers for classification of votes as valid or invalid votes.

In the programme for the elections to the Members of Municipal Councils/Committees and Municipal Corporation, Faridabad as notified by the Commission, directions were given that the counting of votes polled for the elections shall be made at the Polling Stations itself immediately after the close of poll on the same day. On the request of Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad the Commission accorded the approval for counting of votes of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad at the counting centers as specified by the Deputy Commissioner.

Chapter-11

FILLING OF CASUAL VACANCIES

Section 15 of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 provides that whenever a vacancy occurs due to death, resignation, removal or by the vacation of a seat or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled within six months of the occurrence of such vacancy in accordance with the provisions of this Act and Rules. It also provides that every person elected or nominated to fill up a casual vacancy shall be elected or nominated to serve for the remainder of his predecessor's term of office.

After the second General Elections of Municipalities held in the State on 2.4.2000, a total number of 35 casual vacancies which have occurred because of death, resignation, disqualification, removal were filled by the Commission in various by-elections. The detail in this regard is given at page 103-104 of the First Election Report published in the year 2004.

However, details regarding vacant seats/casual vacancies arised due to resignation, death, removal and decision of Election Tribunal from 22.03.2004 till date which have been filled up by holding by-elections, is as under:-

Timing of Ballot Process and Voters' Lists

The expertise of the State Election Commission in the field of law was fully utilized in determining the strategy of economy measures in retaining a large scale saving in preparation and printing of Electoral Lists in the past Municipal Council Elections as the heavy expenditure incurred in the past had been a major concern for the Government.

Expenditure on Ballot

Further, the Government has not yet decided on the issue of printing of private notices and other material to be taken from the Printing Department in the past elections. It is being decided by the Government.

Conclusion

During the election process of Municipal Councils, the Government has decided to take the Deputy Commissioners as the Ballot Officers. Hence, the Government has decided to take a considerable amount on this account.

Annexure

There was a considerable amount of expenditure on account of printing of Ballot Papers. There was a number of cases during the election process. The Municipal Councils, in which a large amount of Rs. 2,58,400 was spent on the printing of Ballot Papers, are listed in the Annexure. Chapter-12

ANALYSIS OF ACHIEVEMENTS OF STATE ELECTION COMMISSIONER DURING HIS TENURE

Printing of Ballot Papers and Voters' Lists

The expertise of the State Election Commissioner in the field of finance was fruitfully utilised to its optimum by adopting the strategy of economy measures in achieving a large scale saving on preparation and printing of Electoral Rolls in the third Municipal General Elections, as the heavy expenditure incurred in the Second Municipal General Elections held in March, 2000.

Transportation during Polls

Besides this, a considerable amount was also saved on account of hiring of private buses and trucks at the rates fixed by State Transport Department, as per past practice, for carrying polling parties to their respective destinations.

Videography

During the current elections of Municipal, no videography was allowed to the Deputy Commissioners as per past practice. Hence, the Commission was able to save a considerable amount on this account also.

Litigation

There has been a substantial decline in the expenditure on account of small number of Court cases. There were a bundle of court cases during the Second Municipal General Elections, 2000, in which a huge amount of Rs.2,26,402 was paid to the private Defence Counsels engaged to defend the cases on behalf of the State Election Commission. Whereas, during the current Municipal General Elections, there were only a few court cases where the Advocate General, Haryana was asked to defend them on behalf of the State Election Commission, thereby saving a huge amount on legal fees which was earlier paid to the Private Counsels.

Office Expenses

The bills on account of electricity and water charges, telephone, fax, POL, Travel Expenses etc. have gone down considerably during the tenure of the present State Election Commissioner because of his being a role model in putting the concept of 'Economy in Expenditure' into real practice thereby setting a fine example for the staff also to follow the same.

The following economy measures were adopted by the State Election Commission:-

1. No expenditure for hiring the private vehicles for transportation/cartage of election material was allowed to the district/field offices.
2. No expenditure on account of entertainment/hospitality to the election staff was incurred resulting in total saving on this account.
3. Economic and optimum utilisation of the election material.
4. Effective monitoring and proper coordination/liaise with the Deputy Commissioners have yielded better results in saving the over all expenditure on the conduct of elections of Urban Local Bodies Institutions.
5. Economy measures were also adopted in the allocation of funds to the Deputy Commissioners-cum-District Election Officers in a very stringent manner to avoid all kinds of wasteful/unnecessary expenditures.

Status of Pendency

No case on the part of the Commission is pending for want of a decision regarding payment of any bill or otherwise where the approval of the State Election Commissioner is involved for final settlement.

Improvement in the system of purchase and management of election material/electronic items

Strenuous efforts were made to streamline/rationalise the purchase and procurement of election material with a view to provide an improvised system to ensure better quality of election material and its timely delivery to the district officers, on requisition made by them. However, it was also ensured that a proper checklist of election material is maintained at the Headquarter to oversee its proper utilisation in the

field offices so that there is no misutilisation and no excess stock on account of extravagant purchase of election material.

To avoid the delay in effecting purchase of office apparatuses/ electronic items which are usually purchased through **HARTRON** which is a time consuming process indeed, the State Election Commission made a departure from the prevailing system and went in for the direct purchase from the open market, after observing the codal formalities and even made profitable purchases on competitive rates by negotiating the bargains with the open competitors in the market, thereby yielding a handsome saving on this account. To make the system more effective and workable, in some cases, the Deputy Commissioners were also allowed to make petty purchases of election material at their own level on the rates, not exceeding to the rates approved by the Commission for the said purpose.

State Election Commission also contacted Haryana Government from time to time for consultation purpose which is mandatory for conduct of elections as per amendment of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994.

All efforts were made for timely allotment/release of funds to enable this Commission to discharge its constitutional obligations in a most successful manner.

The State Election Commission has made a great achievement in accomplishing this stupendous task of conducting the elections in a short period of only 31 days.
