

2. In this context, your attention is drawn to Rule 35(1) of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Election Rules, 1994 and Rule 34(1) of the Haryana

Municipal Election Rules, 1978. In accordance with the provisions of these rules, the Returning Officer is required to set up required number of polling stations. Detailed procedure for setting up polling stations is given in the Handbook issued for the use of Returning Officers. Therefore, you are requested to direct the concerned Returning Officer to immediately set up required number of polling stations for general/by-elections and approval of the same be obtained from the State Election Commission by sending a list of polling stations through your office.

3. I have also been directed to request you that as far as possible polling stations be set up only in government buildings [no polling station be set up in or near any hospital or delivery center]. If for some reason this is not possible, and it becomes necessary to set up a polling station in a Private Building/Dharmashala, prior written approval be obtained from the owner of the Private Building/Dharmashala and it be ensured that no contesting candidate or his/her relative has any connection with that building or institution.
