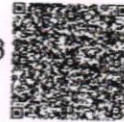

1. Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner will file a representation raising his claim, as raised in the present writ petition, before the authorities concerned, within a period of 07 days from today and the respondents may be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that no prejudice is caused to him.

3. Ms. Anu Pal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana and submits that in case such a representation is received, the same will be decided and appropriate order will be passed within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of such representation. In case, it is found that the claim raised by the petitioner is admissible to him, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in



the said order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information.

4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned Addl. A.G., Haryana, in Court today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having not been pressed any further.

Ravinder Kumar Rawal vs. State of Haryana and others

Present:- Mr. Avinit Avasthi, Advocate for applicant-petitioner.

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Present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner with the apprehension that the last date for finalising the voter list of Municipal Corporation, Panchkula has been notified as 27.03.2026 as per the notification dated 16.02.2026 and in case the representation filed by the applicant-petitioner is not decided before the said date, the same will cause prejudice to the applicant-petitioner.

Notice of the application to the respondents.

Ms. Anu Pal, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the question raised in the representation dated 19.02.2026 filed by the petitioner has no direct connection with the finalization of the voter list and even otherwise, in case after passing the speaking order on the representation of the petitioner any rectification is required, the same can be undertaken.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Rather than complicating the matter, it will be in the interest of justice in case, the representation filed by the petitioner is decided by the competent authority by 25.03.2026. Hence, the respondents are directed to decide the representation filed by the petitioner by 25.03.2026.
