**2. The function of the Committee is as under:**

To review the implementation of the provisions of the Act, scheme for the rights and entitlements of victims and witnesses in accessing justice as specified in sub-section (11) of section 15-A of Chapter IV-A of the Act, relief and rehabilitation facilities provided to the victims and other matters connected therewith, prosecution of cases under the Act, role of different officers/agencies responsible for implementing the provisions of the Act and review of various reports received by State Government including that of Nodal Officer and Special Officer.

3. The Committee shall meet at least twice in a calendar year in the month of January and July.
4. The Headquarter of the Committee will be at Chandigarh.

**Functions of the Committee:**

3. The committee shall review the implementation of the provisions of the Act, relief and rehabilitation facilities provided to the victims and other matters connected therewith, prosecution of the cases under the Act, role of different officers/agencies responsible for implementing the provisions of the Act and various reports received by the District Administration.

**Other**

1. The Headquarter of the Committee will be the concerned District Headquarter.
2. The Committee will meet at least once in three months.
3. The terms of the non-official members will be for a maximum period of three years from the date of the notification. However, the State Government may nominate or withdraw a non-official member at any time.
4. TADA will be given to the non-official members (excluding MPs/MLAs) at the rate of Group 'B' officers of the State Government for attending the meeting along with actual Bus/Train fare.

**Functions of the Committee:**

3. The Committee shall review the implementation of the provisions of the Act, relief and rehabilitation facilities provided to the victims and other matters connected therewith, prosecution of the cases under the Act, role of different officers/agencies responsible for implementing the provisions of the Act and various reports received by the Sub Division Administration.

**Other**

4. The Headquarter of the Committee will be the concerned Sub Division Headquarter.
5. The Committee will meet at least once in three months.
6. The terms of the non-official members will be for a maximum period of three years from the date of the notification. However, the State Government may nominate or withdraw a non-official member at any time.
