## August MAT Report 2017

In August MAT 2017, $99 \%$ of schools have entered data. Across districts, it is more than state average in 3 districts named Fatehabad, Jhajjar and Karnal. It is at par the state average in twelve districts, named Bhiwani, Faridabad, Hisar, Jind, Kaithal, Kurukshetra, Mahendergarh, Panipat, Rewari, Rohtak, Sirsa and Sonipat. In rest of the districts, it is less than the state average (Table 1).

Attendance of students in August MAT 2017, is $93 \%$ at state level. Across districts, attendance is more than state average in 15 districts namely, Ambala, Bhiwani, Fatehabad, Hisar, Jhajjar, Jind, Kaithal, Karnal, Kurukshetra, Mahendergarh, Rewari, Rohtak, Sirsa, Sonipat, Yamuna Nagar. It is less than state average in 4 districts named Panipat, Palwal, Faridabad and Mewat (Table 2).

In August MAT 2017, Mahendergarh district is at first position. Rewari and Sonipat districts are in tie for second position. Jhajjar is at third position. However, Palwal, Yamuna Nagar, and Mewat are the bottom performing districts (Table 3).

In August Mat 2017, across primary classes, in Hindi, English and Mathematics, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3rd in comparison of class 1st and 2nd, however in class 4th and 5th it has improved again. In EVS, performance of students is good as more than $50 \%$ students are achieving more than $50 \%$ marks (Table 4).

Across upper primary classes, in August MAT 2017, in Hindi, performance of students is good and it has increased from class $6^{\text {th }}$ to $8^{\text {th }}$. However, in English, performance of students is poor in all three classes. In Mathematics and Social Studies, performance of students is poor in class $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ however in class $8^{\text {th }}$ it improved and reached $52 \%$ and $51 \%$ respectively i.e. $52 \%$ students of class $8^{\text {th }}$ are scoring more than $50 \%$ marks in mathematics and $51 \%$ students are scoring more than $50 \%$ marks. In Science, students are performing well but the performance is decreasing from class $6^{\text {th }}$ to class $8^{\text {th }}$ (Table 5).

Across Districts, in Hindi, students are performing well in all classes except class 3 in all districts except one or two districts. Performance of class 3 students is poor in all the districts except Faridabad, Gurugram, Jhajjar, Mahendergarh, Rewari and Sonipat. They need more improvement (Table 6).

In English, class $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$ students are performing well in all the districts except Mewat but class $3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}, 6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ students' performance is poor in most of the districts, they need much attention and improvement. In Class $5^{\text {th }}$, students' performance is comparatively better than $3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}, 6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$. Students are performing better in most of the districts. They are performing poorly in Fatehabad, Kaithal, Mewat and Palwal (Table 7).

In Mathematics also, class $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ students are performing well in almost all districts, however, performance level of class $3^{\text {rd }}, 6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ students is very poor in most of the districts, and they need much improvement. Class $8^{\text {th }}$ students are performing poor in 6 districts. In rest of the districts, they are performing well in all the other districts (Table 8).

In EVS, class $3^{\text {rd }}$ students are performing well in all the districts except Mewat. In class $4^{\text {th }}$ and class $5^{\text {th }}$ students are performing well in most of the districts (Table 9).

In Social Studies, across districts, students of class $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ are performing poorly except few districts. They need much improvement. However, in class $8^{\text {th }}$, students are performing well in most of the districts except nine districts (Table 10).

In Science, performance of class $6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ students is good except in Mewat in $6^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ class , except Fatehabad, Kaithal, Mewat and Yamuna Nagar in class $7^{\text {th }}$. Students need improvement in Mewat and Palwal districts across all upper primary classes (Table 11).

## Conclusion:

There is a tremendous decline in performance level of students from class $1^{\text {st }}$ to $3^{\text {rd }}$ in Hindi; however, it has improved again till class $8^{\text {th }}$. Across district, this decline has been observed in all the districts in Hindi. In English, performance of students is started declining in class 3 and improved in class $5^{\text {th }}$ and thereafter declined again in all classes till class 8 in almost all the districts. This is a matter of concern and English language needs more improvement. In Mathematics, downfall is noticed in class $3^{\text {rd }}$ which is improved in class $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$, however declined tremendously in class $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$. In class $8^{\text {th }}$, it has improved to some extent. In EVS, class $3^{\text {rd }}$ students are performing well in all the districts except Mewat. In class $4^{\text {th }}$ and class $5^{\text {th }}$ students are performing well in most of the districts. In Social Studies, across districts, students of class $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ are performing poorly except few districts; however it has improved from class $6^{\text {th }}$ to class $8^{\text {th }}$. In Science, performance of class $6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ students is good in most of the districts.
