## **October MAT Report 2016**

Percentage of schools that have entered data in October MAT, 2016 is 96%. Across districts, it is more than state average in 8 districts named, Bhiwani (97%), Faridabad (97%), Fatehabad (97%), Jhajjar (98%), Kaithal (97%), Rewari (98%), Sirsa (98%) and Sonipat (97%). In four districts, named Hisar, Karnal, Kurukshetra and Panipat, it is at part he state average (96%). In rest of the districts, it is less than the state average (Table 1).

In Oct MAT 2016, Haryana Student attendance is 93%. Sonipat (73%), Mahendergarh (68%) are on first and second position. Gurgaon and Jhajjar (66%) districts are in tie for third positions. However, Fatehabad (47%), Palwal (47%), Panchkula (47%), Yamuna Nagar (43%) and Mewat (36%) are the bottom performing districts (Table 3).

Across primary classes, in Oct 2016, in Hindi, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3rd in comparison of class 1st and 2nd, however in class 4th and 5th it has increased again slowly. In English, it decreases as we move from class 1st to 4th, however, increased again in class 5<sup>th</sup>. In Mathematics, performance of students is somewhat kind of zigzag, increased in class 2nd, decreased in class 3rd again increased in class 4th then decreased in class 5th. In EVS, performance has marginally increased from class 3rd to class 5th.

Across upper primary classes, in Oct MAT 2016, in Hindi, English, Science and Social Sciences, performance of students has increased from class 6<sup>th</sup> to class 8<sup>th</sup>. In Mathematics, performance has decreased from class 6<sup>th</sup> to class 7<sup>th</sup> but again marginally increased in class 8<sup>th</sup>.

Across Districts, in Hindi, Class  $1_{st}$ ,  $2_{nd}$  and  $8^{th}$ , students are performing well in all districts but the performance of class  $3_{rd}$  is poor in most of the districts, they need improvement. Performance of students in class  $4^{th}$ ,  $5^{th}$ ,  $6^{th}$ ,  $7^{th}$  they are performing well in almost all districts (Table 6).

In English, class 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 8<sup>th</sup> students are performing well but class 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th students' performance level is low, they need much improvement. In class 4<sup>th</sup>, situation is worst comparatively (Table 7).

In Mathematics also, class 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> students are performing well in almost all districts, however, performance level of class 6th, 7th and 8th students is very poor in most of the districts, and they need much improvement (Table 8).

In science, performance of class 6th, 7th and 8th students is well except in Mewat and Palwal. Students need improvement in Mewat and Palwal districts across all upper primary classes (Table 11).

**Conclusion:** Performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3<sup>rd</sup> in all subjects (Hindi, English and Mathematics). This decrease may be due to more emphasis on writing skills in class 3<sup>rd</sup>. The performance of students in English has decreased further in Class 4<sup>th</sup>. Performance of students across almost all districts is very poor in class 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> class in Social Studies. However, in Science, students of all three classes 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> are performing well.
