

# “A CHALLENGE FOR CLASS 3 AND CLASS 6 TEACHERS”

(MAY MONTHLY ASSESSMENT REPORT- 2015)

- 1- In the May Month percentage of Schools, that have entered data, is 98% at State Level. Out of 21 districts only in Jhajjar, Kaithal, Karnal, Rewari, Sirsa, all schools have entered data. (Table 1).

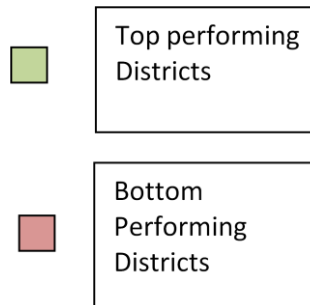

- 2- The percentage of the students who appeared in the May MAT is 88% of the total students enrolled. In Faridabad, Gurgaon, Mewat, Palwal, Panchkula & Panipat districts the percentage of students to have appeared fall below 90% (Table 2).

3- Jhajjar, Mahendergarh, Rewari and Gurgaon are best performing districts. Whereas, Mewat, Palwal & Yamuna Nagar are the least performing districts (Table 3).

- 4- (i) It has been observed that there is sharp decline in the achievement level of Students who have scored 50% and above from class-2 to class-3. Possible reason for this decline could be due to difference in pedagogical practices & textbooks. Subject specific decline in English is 30%, in Hindi 20% & in Math 15%.
- (ii) In class-4 & class-5 marginal increase in achievement level of students is observed in all subjects except Mathematics.
- (iii) Marginal increase of approximately 5% in achievement level of students in EVS is observed from class-3 to class-5 (Table 4).

- 5- (i) A similar decline is also observed in class-5 to class-6. This could be due to Change in school from Primary to Elementary, change in the set of teachers, subject specific pedagogy and shift from state textbooks to NCERT textbooks.
- (ii) Subject specific decline in Hindi is 10% from class-5 to class-6 with the slight improvement 3% in class-7 and 4% in class-8.
- (iii) In English, decline in achievement level is of 15% with the slight improvement of 5 % in class-7 and 4% in class-8.
- (iv) In Mathematics, 11% decline is observed from class-5 to class-6 with further decline of 4% in class-7.
- (v) In Science, achievement level of students improved in class-7 by 6% and in class-8 by 7%.
- (vi) In Social Science, improvement of 4% in class-7 and class-8 is observed (Table 5).
