

November MAT Report 2016

Percentage of schools that have entered data in November MAT, 2016 is 96%. Across districts, it is more than state average in 8 districts named, Ambala (97%), Faridabad (97%), Fatehabad (97%), Karnal (98%), Panipat (98%), Rewari (98%), Sirsa (97%) and Sonipat (97%). In four districts, named Bhiwani, Jhajjar, Jind and Kurukshetra, it is at par the state average (96%). In rest of the districts, it is less than the state average (Table 1).

In Oct MAT 2016, Haryana Student attendance is 93%. Across districts, attendance is more than state average in 13 districts namely, 96% in Sonipat, Yamuna Nagar , Bhiwani, Jhajjar, Rewari, 95% in Hisar, Rohtak, Mahendergarh, Ambala and 94% in Kurukshetra, Karnal, Kaithal and Jind (Table 2).

Across primary classes, in Nov 2016, in Hindi, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3rd in comparison of class 1st and 2nd, however in class 4th, it has increased again and in 5th class, it has reached to same level. In English, it decreases as we move from class 1st to 4th, however, increased again in class 5th. In Mathematics, performance of students is increased in class 2nd, decreased in class 3rd till 5th. In EVS, performance has increased from class 3rd to class 5th.

Across upper primary classes, in Oct MAT 2016, in Hindi, English, Science and Social Sciences, performance of students has increased from class 6th to class 8th. In Mathematics, performance has increased in class 7th but decreased in class 8th.

Across Districts, in Hindi, Class 1st, 2nd and 8th, students are performing well in all districts. Performance of students in class 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th is well in almost all districts. But the performance of class 3rd is poor in most of the districts, they need improvement. (Table 6).

In English, class 1st, 2nd and 7th students are performing well but class 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 8th students' performance level is low, they need much improvement (Table 7).

In Mathematics also, class 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th students are performing well in almost all districts, however, performance level of class 6th, 7th and 8th students is very poor in most of the districts, and they need much improvement. Performance of class 5th is also not so good but somewhat better than class 6th, 7th and 8th (Table 8).
