

Jan MAT Report 2017

Percentage of schools that have entered data in Jan MAT, 2017 is 97%. Across districts, it is more than state average in 12 districts named, Bhiwani (98%), Faridabad (99%), Fatehabad (99%), Jhajjar (98%), Kaithal (99%), Karnal (98%), Kurukshetra (98%), Mewat (98%), Palwal (98%), Rewari (98%), Sirsa (99%) and Panipat (99%). In four districts, named Hisar, Jind Panchkula and Sonipat , it is at par the state average (96%). In rest of the districts, it is less than the state average (Table 1).

In Jan MAT 2017, Haryana Student attendance is 94%. Across districts, attendance is more than state average in 14 districts namely, Yamuna Nagar (97%), Hisar (97%), Sonipat (96%), Bhiwani (96%), Jhajjar (96%), Mahendergarh (96%), Rewari (96%), Rohtak (96%), Kaithal (96%), Ambala (96%), Kurukshetra (95%), Karnal (96%), Panchkula (95%), Jind (95%) (Table 2).

Mahendergarh (68%), Sonipat (67%) and Rewari (65%) are on first, second and third position. Gurgaon (64%) and Jhajjar (63%) districts are at fourth and fifth positions. However, Karnal (50%), Yamuna Nagar (49%) and Mewat (44%) are the bottom performing districts (Table 3).

Across primary classes, in Jan 2017, in Hindi, performance of students has decreased tremendously in class 3rd in comparison of class 1st and 2nd, however in class 4th and 5th it has increased again. In English, it decreases as we move from class 1st to 4th, however, increased marginally again in class 5th. In Mathematics, performance of students is decreased in class 3rd but again increased in class 4th then decreased in class 5th. In EVS, performance has marginally increased from class 3rd to class 5th.

Across upper primary classes, in Oct MAT 2016, in Hindi, English, Mathematics and Social Sciences, performance of students has increased from class 6th to class 8th. In Science, performance has decreased from class 6th to class 7th but again marginally increased in class 8th.

Across Districts, in Hindi, Class 1st, 2nd, 7th and 8th, students are performing well in all districts but the performance of class 3rd is poor in most of the districts, they need improvement. Performance of students in class 4th, 5th, 6th, they are performing well in almost all districts (Table 6).
