Introduction

Every textbook has "Notes for the teacher" In this it is told why the learning of language is important and how it can be acquired. Language becomes alive when presented in meaning-making context. Interaction, discussion and sharing of ideas among learners provide great opportunity in the learning process.

Basic thing is firsthand knowledge about lesson, which can be acquired only by reading it with a strong hold on vocabulary. So, teachers in class room should take care that students are getting good command on contents of the lesson as well as on words, their meaning in different contexts, application (usability) etc. Encourage learners to work in pairs and in small groups. Teachers should facilitate them to go beyond the textbook by providing them variety of inputs for the spontaneous and natural use of language.

To promote joyful learning in class room one must keep in mind that it should be done all the time. Poetry should be taught with singing gesture, individual as well as in group (choral recitation). Dramatisation of text is an important art/ effort/ act to make learning indelible.

Teacher should have pre knowledge of competencies (on daily/weekly/monthly/annual basis). With the help of text provided in the books, add once imagination to make it much elaborated/understandable for students. Once teachers become successful in doing all this: knowledge become indelible, everlasting. Thus purpose of teaching is achieved.

In text books every page has a column for words and meanings. Encourage children to write down other words they find difficult, along with their meanings. It provides an opportunity to increase vocabulary.

Guidelines for Teachers:-

- 1. Success has no short cuts. Practice makes a man perfect.
- 2. These worksheets are supplementary material only, which are developed with the help of competencies mentioned for classes 3, 5 & 7.
- 3. Teachers must focus on prescribed text books as a lot of exercises are given in these books.
- 4. In this Practice Material for Saksham Plus exercises are provided to facilitate teachers in the field.
- 5. On the basis of these worksheets teachers are expected to prepare more resource material for regular assessment on the same pattern and use it in the classes on day to day basis.
- 6. It is expected from teachers that they will focus on Activity Based Learning (ABL) to teach the competencies.
- 7. The teachers should study the competencies mentioned in Saksham Talika or mentioned on SCERT Website (http://scertharyana.gov.in/) by clicking on Month Wise Distribution of Syllabus.

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
