Key challenges faced by school during lockdown (Covid 19) in the year 2020-2021

- Lack of communication with students was the initial challenge with school staff. Many students had not the facility of smart phones at that time, so we were not able to communicate with them.
- Many students were not able to participate in weekly quizzes because of non-availability of smart phone.
- When schools were opened to take queries, only a few students used to come for queries. Mostly students had not visited school.
- In the last months of the session, it was very difficult to cover the syllabus at time.
- School timing was not proper. It was impossible to attend the students of all classes' from 6th to 12th.
- Parents were not willing to send their children to school because of fear of Covid.



Innovations (along with teachers and community) brought about to ensure school functioning and student learning as a school leader

- As a school leader, I had motivated my staff members to contact at least 10 students per day, and had asked to contact their parents so that they could share their child's problems with teachers.
- I had also motivated teachers to visit the home of students and had made them to motivate students to study and to talk to parents directly. Teachers were asked to make aware students regarding sanitation, and use of proper masks.
- I had motivated staff members to visit the home of those students who had not the facilities of smart phones so that they could do weekly quizzes by using their teachers' smart phones.
- Neighbours of students were approached to become 'Shiksha Mitra' of students who did not have facility of smart phones.
- I had also tried to call at least 20 students per day and take queries and had motivated students to study at home.
- I had also motivated teachers to take online classes, and to take online exams by using Google forms.
- I had also motivated students to participate in online exams like VVM exam, NFLAT exam, and had also motivated them to take part in activities related to NEP and other online act initiated by the Govt. of India and also by the government of Haryana from time to time.
- I had also try to assess students progress by conducting online exam with the help of all staff members and also conducted E-PTM.
- Sanitation, proper use of masks, social distance were implemented properly.
- Books were distributed from book bank among students through door to door campaigning.



School and teachers collaborated with SMC, community members and parents/families to facilitate learning of students during lockdown

- Meetings were organized through Google meet with SMC members, their problems were taken into consideration and suggestion was also taken.



Prepared the school to face the Covid 19 challenges in the year 2021-2022 and ensure student learning

- In the session 2021-22, online classes through Google meet were taken from the very starting.
- Many parents are now aware of the benefits of smart phones in this changing scenario.
- Parents are being made aware from time to time to keep an eye on their children so that he/she will do appropriate use of smart phone.
- Students are being given limited homework. Proper care is taken about their eyesight and other health issues.
- Sanitation, proper social distancing and use of masks are implementing.
