SUB:- Online submission/registration/renewal of eligible beneficiaries under National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for the academic year 2022-23 - Regarding.

This is regarding the online submission/registration of eligible beneficiaries under National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme(NMMSS) on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for the academic year **2022-23** i.e. class-IX of project year **2022-23** (NMMSS exam held on March 2022), class-X of the project year 2021-22 (NMMSS Exam held on Dec. 2020), class-XI of the project year 2020-21 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2019) and class-XII of the project year 2019-20 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2018). National Scholarship Portal (NSP) has been opened w.e.f. 20 July 2022 for online fresh registration for NMMSS exam **March 2022** and for **renewal of registration for previous NMMSS exams as well.**

Therefor, you are requested to ensure that all the stakeholders of your District to get themselves registered/renewed on NSP in time-bound manner so as to enable this scheme to be fully on-boarded on NSP as **directed by DBT Mission and Cabinet Secretariat," no exemption will be given this year under any circumstances. Therefore, all the District Co-ordinations are strictly advised to adhere to the last date."**

The students of previous academic year i.e. 2021-22, who had applied on National Scholarship Portal last year for class-IX, X and XI of the project year 2021-22 (NMMSS Exam held on Dec. 2020), 2020-21 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2019) and 2019-20 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2018) respectively are not required to create new registration ID again on the NSP Portal i.e. the registration IDs of last year (2020-21) will be applicable.

The already registered students have to select the option "Apply for Renewal" for applying the scholarship for classes-X, XI and XII of the project year 2021-22 (NMMSS Exam held on Dec. 2020), 2020-21 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2019) and 2019-20 (NMMSS Exam held on Nov. 2018) respectively.

The students of project year 2022-23 (NMMSS Exam held in March 2022) need to apply/register themselves on NSP Portal with the option "New Registration" on the NSP Portal and then select the option "Login to Apply".

The students of project year 2022-23 (NMMSS Exam held in March 2022) applying on NSP Portal for class-IX are required to enter "NMMSS Roll No." mandatorily".

The students applying for class-IX and X have to select the Pre-matric Scholarship Scheme while the students applying for class-XI and XII have to select the Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme during application.

You are directed to instruct the School Principals/Headmasters as well as your District level co-ordinator of this scheme to be very careful while verifying the applications of the students.
