The Rajya Stariya Bal Vaigyanik Pradarshani was organized from 29th January-30th January, 2024 at the campus of State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT) Gurugram, Haryana.

This year around 500 participants (district winners) along with their teachers from across the state participated in exhibition. Around 1000 students from different government and private schools from different districts also visited the state level science exhibition.

Team of 2 judges for each subtheme (Total 10) was called from various universities for judgement of exhibits.

On 30th January, 2024 subject specialists from SCERT, DSS from different districts conducted the open science Quiz for all participating students of exhibition. Quiz was held in 2 groups i.e. 6th-8th and 9th-12th. Certificates, Trophies and cash prizes of First@2500/-Second@,2000/, Third@,1500/- were announced for winners from both the groups separately.



Sh. Amarnath (Retd. IAS) was the chief guest for the valedictory session and prize distribution function on 30th January, 2024. Sh. Amarnath while addressing the children said that they should not be disheartened that their model was not selected. The reaching of the model to the state level itself is a great achievement. Event Coordinator & Subject Specialist Jyoti Arora declared the result of the exhibition. Certificates, Trophies and cash prizes of First@5000/-Second@,4000/-Third@,3000/- were distributed by Chief Guest Sh. Amarnath (Retd. IAS) with Director SCERT Sunil Bajaj, Smt. 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Finalization of MOOC

The "Empowering Education With ICT" Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) was designed by the Educational Technology (ET) Wing of SCERT Gurugram. This MOOC was conceived with the goal of disseminating knowledge about the effective integration of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in Education. The course was strategically designed to align with the principles of the National Education Policy 2020. The course is hosted on the learning management system with the web address Imshry.click, developed by the ET Wing SCERT Gurugram, Haryana.

The course's reach extended beyond geographical boundaries, targeting educators from various states across India and even internationally. Utilizing modern platforms and social media, a Google link was shared, resulting in an overwhelming response of 2710 teachers expressing their interest within a short span of 15 days. To ensure an enriching learning experience, each module incorporated diverse teaching methods. Video lectures, textual content, interactive materials, and supplementary reading materials were seamlessly integrated. Participants were actively engaged through assignments, ensuring practical application of acquired knowledge. Additionally, assessment quizzes accompanied each module, providing a robust evaluation mechanism.

The response from participants exceeded expectations, with 256 educators successfully completing the course. This not only reflects the relevance of the course content but also underscores the commitment of educators to enhance their skills and adapt to modern teaching methodologies. Certificates of completion were awarded to all 256 participants, recognizing their dedication and successful acquisition of knowledge. The certification serves as a testament to their commitment to professional development.

2.District Level Mentor Compliance: Top 5 districts in district level Mentor Compliance in December 2023 were Panchkula, Palwal, Rewari, Fatehabad, Karnal and bottom 5 districts were Faridabad, Panipat, Mahendragarh, Jhajjar, Bhiwani.

3.Percentage District School Coverage:Top 5 Districts in percentage district school coverage in December 2023 were Hisar, Ambala, Rohtak, Fatehabad, Sirsa and bottom 5 districts were Nuh, Palwal, Faridabad, Yamuna Nagar, Gurugram.

4.District & Block Level Reviews :17 out of 22 districts finished district level reviews and 107 out of 119 Blocks finished block level reviews. Following districts failed to complete district reviews – Ambala, Karnal, Bhiwani, Charkhi Dadri, Sonipat.


LEAD Online Course Mentors Orientation Workshop

Guest Lecture Series: Successful POCSO Awareness Campaign Empowers School Leaders in Haryana

In a commendable effort to raise awareness on the critical role of school leaders in preventing and addressing child abuse, a comprehensive Online-session on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was organized by Department of School Leadership, SCERT, Haryana. The session was addressed by Ms. Roshni Sharma, Retired Block Education Officer (BEO). The initiative, launched with words of wisdom from Joint Director Sh. Sunil Bajaj, aimed to equip school leaders with the necessary knowledge and skills to safeguard children from sexual offenses. The session was organised to inculcate a sense of responsibility among school leaders regarding the safety of students in schools, their role in creating awareness among school teachers, students and community regarding POCSO act. This session was a post-initiative after successful completion of one-day training received by all school leaders from January 1 to January 6 at the block level under the aegis of SCERT Haryana.

In a concerted effort to foster a safer environment for students across schools in Haryana, the Department of School Leadership, SCERT Haryana, spearheaded an extensive one-day orientation on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act. Facilitated by a cohort of 1,325 resource persons trained by DIETs faculty, who themselves underwent a rigorous Training of Trainers (TOT) program by HIPA Haryana over two days, the event underscored a holistic approach towards capacity building and dissemination of crucial information.

The comprehensive curriculum of the orientation delved into various aspects of the POCSO Act, including its legal framework, key provisions, reporting mechanisms, and measures for prevention and redressal of child sexual abuse.
