Topic of Science Seminar 2024: Artificial Intelligence: Potentials & Concerns” (कृत्रिम बुद्धिमता: संभाव्यता और सरोकार)

You are instructed to conduct **Block Level by 9th August, 2024** and **District Level event by 18th August, 2024** and send the results positively by **20th August, 2024** at sciencewingscert1@gmail.com. Direct the DSS to give due publicity of the event and intimate the dates of district level event to this council.

The instructions and norms for organizing the Block level and District level Science Seminar is as under:

S.No.	Eligibility	Students from class VIII to X from any CBSE/ HBSE recognized school.
1.	Language	English, Hindi or any other recognized Indian Language
2.	Duration of Presentation	(i) 5-6 minutes (This will be followed by a 2 minutes question-answer session with the judges on the same topic. Each participant will be asked 3 questions by the judges and the participant should answer any 2 of them within 2 minutes).
3.	Supporting Visuals	(i) Posters, charts or computer based static slides (MS office 2019 or lower) restricted to 5 in

		number (maximum number of visuals should not be more than 5)
4.	Evaluation Criteria	1. Scientific Content in presentation = 40 marks
		2. Novelty in use of visuals = 15 marks
		3. Fluency in Speech = 25 marks
		4. Ability to answer questions (a) Written aptitude (20 questions) = 10 marks
		(b) Answer to Oral Questions = 10 marks

Read the instructions carefully to avoid any ambiguity. Only first and second Position winner (**two winners**) of the district level event will take part in the state level seminar. The first prize winner from each state will be eligible to participate in National Science Seminar.
