### **Assessment Reforms: Capacity-Building Initiatives Under NEP 2020**

The Assessment Team at SCERT is actively implementing assessment reforms in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 guidelines. The primary focus is on building the capacity of Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs) in English, Hindi, Mathematics, and Science to develop competency-based question papers that emphasize higher-order thinking skills and real-world applications.

Two meetings were held on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024 and 28<sup>th</sup> November 2024, attended by officials from SCERT and the SAKSHAM team, along with representatives from Educational Initiatives (EI). These meetings laid the



foundation for the reform plan, finalizing facilitators, session plans, and workshop presentations. Attendees included Dr. Manoj Sharma, Head of the Testing & Assessments Cell at SCERT, Ms. Vandana, and Dr. Sheetal from the same department. From the SAKSHAM team, Smt. Pragya Mathur, Smt. Shraya Sapru, Smt. Priyal Batheja, and Sh. Prahalad Balaji played key roles in the discussions.

The meetings focused on designing competency-based assessments that prioritize real-world applications and critical thinking. Plans were developed to create blueprints for the Annual Assessments in March 2025 and Half-Yearly Assessments in 2025 for Classes 6-8 in English, Hindi, Mathematics, and Science. Additionally, a competency-based question bank comprising 1,200 questions will be created, including 600 newly developed questions with input from TGTs and 600 customized, open-sourced questions. For Mathematics and Science, these questions will be bilingual (English and Hindi) to align with Haryana's curriculum requirements.

Workshops for 120 TGTs are scheduled for the second and third weeks of December 2024. These workshops aim to build teachers' capacity to create high-quality, competency-based questions. Facilitators for these sessions have been identified, and the sequence of training and lesson plans was finalized during the meetings.

# Monitoring of PGT Training at GSSS Kherki Daula

On 12<sup>th</sup> November 2024, Dr. Manoj Sharma and Ms. Vandana Chopra visited GSSS Kherki Daula to monitor ongoing PGT training sessions conducted by the DIET faculty of Gurugram. The training was organized into four groups, with two focusing on English, one on Economics, and one on Sociology. During their visit, Dr. Sharma and Ms. Chopra interacted with participants to understand their experiences and



perspectives. They encouraged teachers to apply the strategies discussed in the training sessions to enhance classroom practices and improve student learning outcomes. The visit underscored the importance of continuous professional development and its impact on effective teaching practices.

# **Session for PGT Biology**

Dr. Sheetal conducted a session for Master Trainers as part of the TGT training program on the topic "Know Your Surroundings." The session focused on exploring and understanding various plants in the environment. Dr. Sheetal emphasized the importance of biodiversity and encouraged participants to observe and study local plant species to enhance their understanding of the natural world. The session aimed to equip trainers



with knowledge and strategies to inspire curiosity about the environment among students and integrate environmental awareness into classroom teaching.

## Training of DLCs for PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024

A training session for District Level Coordinators (DLCs), including all DEOs and DIET Principals from each district of Haryana, was conducted in preparation for the PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024. The session aimed to clarify the duties and responsibilities of DLCs to ensure the smooth implementation of the survey at the district level. The survey is scheduled for 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024 across the state.



The session was led by Dr. Manoj Sharma (In-charge, Assessment Wing) and Ms. Vandana Chopra (Coordinator for PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan 2024 in Haryana). They provided comprehensive guidance on the survey procedures, timelines, and expectations for coordinators.

PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan is a national-level initiative to assess student learning outcomes across all states. The survey will cover approximately 83 lakh students nationwide. In Haryana, it will be conducted in 2,067 schools, reaching around 55,000 students. This initiative marks a significant step toward evaluating student competencies on a large scale. The insights derived from the survey will play a crucial role in shaping evidence-based strategies to improve education quality at both state and national levels.



### **National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS)**

The NMMS exam for the year 2024 was held on 17th November 2024 in Haryana. A total of 49,280 candidates registered, of which 43,642 appeared for the examination. A total of 2,337 candidates will be selected for the scholarship from Haryana. The question paper was divided into two parts: Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and Mental Ability Test (MAT), each carrying 90 marks. The minimum cut-off marks for the general category are 40% (36 marks), and for reserved categories, 36% (32 marks) in each section.

The Examination Wing of SCERT Haryana will prepare the merit list, which will be posted on the SCERT website. Successful candidates must register on the National Scholarship Portal to claim the scholarship.

Launched in May 2008, the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS) aims to award scholarships to meritorious students from economically weaker sections to reduce dropouts at Class VIII and encourage continuation of studies at the secondary stage. A scholarship of Rs. 12,000 per annum (Rs. 1,000 per month) is awarded to selected students from Class IX to XII in State Government, Government-aided, and local body-run schools.

Students whose parental income does not exceed Rs. 3,50,000 annually are eligible for the scholarship. State Government reservation norms apply. Students studying in Kendriya Vidyalayas, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, or Residential Schools run by the State Government are not eligible. Similarly, students in private schools are also excluded from this scheme.

# Workshop for Capacity Building of National Resource Groups (NRGs) on NISHTHA Educational Technology Level-2 Nov 5-14, 2024

CIET-NCERT organized a 10-day F2F training program to enhance the digital competencies of teachers and school administrators and prepare them as digital teachers. NISHTHA ET- Level 2 modules will be piloted with National Resource Groups (NRGs) during 2024 - 25. The primary goal of this NRG training is to empower the participants with essential competencies for integrating technology into their teaching-learning and assessment processes.

These NRG will be responsible for undertaking activities within their respective regions and assisting in training State Resource Groups (SRGs) for



SCERTs/ DIETs/ CTEs/ IASEs/ BIETs/ Samagra Shiksha etc. To achieve this, a face-to-face training program on NISHTHA Educational Technology Level-2 for NRGs was scheduled in a phased manner at CIET-NCERT, New Delhi from Nov 5-14, 2024.

Five members nominated by SCERT from all over the state, including Ms Anita Sharma from E.T.wing, participated in this workshop.

# Conduction of Monthly Reviews of Elementary Mentoring at the State Level of Nov 8, 2024

Elementary teacher mentoring is crucial for improving teaching practices, building confidence, and addressing challenges faced in classrooms. It supports professional development, fosters effective pedagogy, and enhances student learning outcomes. Mentoring also helps retain teachers by providing guidance, emotional support, and growth opportunities. Ultimately, it ensures quality education at the foundational level.

Educational technology wing SCERT organizes monthly reviews of Sahyogis and mentors every month.

- November review was organized on 8th Nov 2024 through online mode.
- As a regular practice, the monthly review targets for all mentors is being issued from SCERT. The target letter was issued on 5th Nov'2024 along with the Block and district review (13th Nov and 18th Nov) letter.
- 320 mentors (BRPs, ABRCs, DIET faculty) attended this review organized on ZOOM.

### Orientation sessions on 21st Century Skills MOOC

SCERT Haryana launched its second MOOC course on 21st Century Skills in collaboration with Leadership For Equity (LFE) on Haryana's own LMS "Prashikshak".

Over 1,800 officers have registered for the course and they attended the first orientation session on

November 11, 2024, via YouTube Live. During the session, participants were introduced to the course's key features and navigated a demo to familiarize themselves with the platform.

Mr. Manoj Kaushik, Head of ET Wing, emphasized the importance of this course in today's context, particularly for education mentors. He highlighted how acquiring 21st-century skills is crucial for effective teaching and learning. Joint Director Sunil Bajaj also shared special remarks, encouraging participants to leverage this opportunity for professional growth.

A subsequent orientation session was conducted for District Mentors on November 19, 2024, equipping them to facilitate effective Peer Learning Circles (PLCs). The orientation session has received exceptional ratings: 3.6/4 for engagement, 3.7/4 for usefulness and 3.8/4 for doubt clearance. They were



also normed on the Data Management Sheets and its usage. Over 1200+ officers have already embarked on their learning journey.

With its commitment to fostering continuous learning and growth among education leaders, SCERT Haryana is driving excellence in education.

### Meeting regarding the Science Olympiad

A meeting was organized by o/o SPD on 12th November 2024, regarding the planning and organization State Science Olympiad. The meeting organised under the chairmanship of W/JSPD, was attended by Sh Manoj Kaushik, Head E.T Wing, Dr. Sanjay Kaushik Sub.Spl.Science wing and Ms Sonali Vohra consultant Science at o/o SPD Samagra Shiksha, Panchkula. A proposal was drafted and submitted per the JSPD directions.

Through this online utility, the undersigned will discuss each DIET's efforts, challenges, and best practices in various areas like training, research, content development, mentoring, etc. in a detailed review meeting for further improvement.

In this reference, SCERT conducted its seventh Prashikshak Haryana-DIET Review meeting of all DIETs on 19/11/2024, the meeting was conducted online for the first time.

## Capacity building of teachers and teacher educators for DIKSHA

SCERT Haryana, the nodal agency for DIKSHA and EDUSAT Haryana, is working on Teacher Professional Development in areas of digital content development, online Teaching Learning resources, and online courses. Based on CIET-NCERT's SRG orientation, team Haryana prepared a State eContent development plan for 2024-25. This program is important and intended to prepare more than 2500 teachers and trainers, in skills of eContent Development. All these teachers will join the existing Content creator team of SCERT Haryana and contribute to the State Repository of Open Educational Resources (SROER)

In the continuation of this Educational Technology wing organized a workshop from 25-11-2024 to 29-11-2024. Total 13 participants attended this workshop.

Following topics/session were covered -

- ICT integrated Pedagogy
- Script Writing and Evaluation of videos
- Video Recording
- Presentation skill
- Infographics
- Video Editing
- Video Recording and Discussion by participants
- OER and Licenses



Total 08 Practical Sessions, 7 Hands-on sessions, Studio recording of every participants were scheduled and District presentation was also conducted in the morning session every day. Pre-test, assignments, learnings, post-test and feedback were conducted on SCERT LMS Portal. 13 participants were provided participation certificates.

### **Capacity Development of Teachers on Digital Literacy**

For spreading awareness about Tech. initiatives of the school and department, a capacity development program of **Teachers' Training on 'Digital Literacy'**, was organize on 25-29 Nov 2024. The primary objectives of this training program are threefold: to enhance teachers' digital skills, to help them integrate digital tools into their teaching, and to improve student engagement through the use of technology. By achieving these objectives, the program aims to elevate the overall quality of education and ensure that students are better prepared for the digital age. Training was conducted through interactive sessions, hands-on practice, and peer learning activities. Interactive sessions introduced Digital Literacy Concepts,



while hands-on sessions allowed teachers to practice using these tools in a supportive environment.

Participants' registration was done on *Prashikshak Haryana*. To measure the effectiveness of the training program, both pre-training and post-training assessments was also conducted. Additionally, participant feedback was collected to ensure that the training met their needs and expectations. Total 33 participants attended this workshop.

- Digital Tools for Teaching Word Processing- Presentations, Spreadsheets

A total 09 Practical Sessions, 9 Hands-on sessions, and District presentation were conducted in every day. 33 participants were provided participation certificates.

- 7. Progress Report Sharing: Regular progress reports are being shared with all associated stakeholders to ensure transparency and accountability.
- 8. Data Analysis and Motivation: Comparative analysis of block and district-level data is being conducted to motivate teachers at all levels to perform better.
- 9. Doubt Clearing Sessions: DIET members are conducting doubt clearing sessions to address queries and concerns, ensuring smooth implementation of DIKSHA Utsav.


# E-Learning Initiatives and the Role of Educational Administrators in NEP 2020 Implementation




# **Mentoring Workshop for State winner of Science Seminar**
