#### **DLEPC for INSPIRE MANAK**

The preparation for District Level Science Exhibition & Project Competition (DLEPC) for 814 students selected in AY 2024-25 has begun from 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025. The letter for initiation of development of exhibits has been issued from the o/o Director SCERT on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025. The students have been instructed to upload their exhibit, video and write up on MANAK app on or before 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025. It is being intimated that in AY 2024-25 Haryana submitted 22000 ideas and 814 students are selected for award of Rs. 10000 for their ideas by Department of Science & Technology, GoI. The DLEPC for these 814 students will be conducted through online mode in coming months.

#### **DIET Science Faculties' Meeting**

will be covering the syllabus as per monthly distribution of syllabus. The first episode of Science Sutra was telecasted on official youtube channel of Science Wing SCERT on **28**<sup>th</sup> **April 2025**. The episode started with words of wisdom by Deputy Director Smt. Saroj Dahiya. State Coordinator Dr. Jyoti Arora and Subject Specialist Dr. Sanjay Prakash Kaushik were also present during the session and moderated the talk.

# Distribution of the Syllabus for Classes 4th to 8th

The Month-wise Distribution of the Syllabus for Classes 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> was uploaded on the SCERT Website to assist in Structured learning. Additionally, new textbooks for Classes 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> were made available online. To ensure educational equity, textbooks for classes 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> were printed and distributed free of cost to Government Schools students by Department of Elementary Education, Haryana under the Samagra Shiksha initiative for the academic session 2025-26. These efforts aim to enhance accessibility and improve the quality of education across all government schools.

#### NMMS Final Results Declared – 2337 Students from Haryana Selected for Scholarship

On April 23, 2025, the State Council for Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Haryana, announced the final results of the National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) Scheme for the 2024–25 session. This centrally sponsored initiative aims to reduce dropouts among meritorious students from

economically weaker sections studying in government schools by providing financial assistance to support their secondary education.

Under this scheme, 2,337 students from Haryana have been selected to receive a scholarship of ₹12,000 per year for the next four years. The scholarship examination, conducted by SCERT Haryana on November 17, 2024, saw participation from 43,642 students across the state. The selection quota for Haryana is fixed at 2,337 students annually.

Selected students must register on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) to claim their scholarship amount. Registration is expected to begin in July 2025. Students are reminded that failing to register within the specified timeframe will result in forfeiture of the scholarship, in accordance with the scheme's rules.

For further assistance and guidance regarding the registration process, selected students should contact the Institutional Nodal Officer (INO) at their respective schools.

#### State-Level Meeting Held to Finalize Annual Assessment Plan

On April 9, 2025, a state-level meeting was convened with the Assessment Cells of all District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs) across Haryana to discuss the Annual Assessment Plan. This comprehensive document outlines the academic assessment calendar for the year, covering School-Based Assessments (SBA), Student Assessment Tests (SAT), Half-Yearly Assessments, Pre-Board Assessments, and Annual Exams for students in Grades 4 to 12.

The Annual Assessment Plan serves as a key reference for scheduling academic activities throughout the year. Detailed guidelines for conducting SBA activities have been included in the plan. The meeting also focused on the weightage structure of SBAs, SAT cycles, and term-end assessments, including half-yearly and annual exams.

Valuable feedback and suggestions were invited from the DIET Assessment Cell teams to refine and finalize the



document. The meeting saw active participation from all members of the Testing & Assessment Wing, along with 42 representatives from various DIETs across the state.

## **Skill Assessment Tool Finalization Meeting**

The skill-based module is currently being implemented in three districts of Haryana by the Magic Bus Foundation. On April 17th, 2025, representatives from the Magic Bus Foundation met with members of the Testing & Assessment Wing to finalise the skill assessment tools.

### **Training in Action Research**

All DIETs have submitted the names of six TGTs of English, Social Science, Science & Maths as per requirement of REAP Cell. The names have been collated and list prepared for training in Action Research.

#### **Dipstick Study on Mental Health**

An Online meeting on the same was held on 04.04.2025 with select DIET & School faculty, including ARAs, Psychology Subject Specialists in DIETs & one School faculty. Questionnaires have been developed by each participant and submitted to REAP Cell.



#### **PPT Presentation**

A PPT on NEP 2020 & REAP Cell was prepared & presented by Incharge REAP Cell at SCERT on 15.04.2025. It contained details on how Research may be incorporated as per NEP Guidelines as well as a mention of Thematic Studies.
