**ORDINANCE FOR ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO THE POST GRADUATE
DIPLOMA COURSE IN INDUSTRIAL SAFETY MANAGEMENT**

1.0 The Post Graduate Diploma Course in Industrial Safety Management will be of one year duration (2 semester) and shall be designated as Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Safety Management and abbreviated as PGDISM.

2.0 Admission

2.1 The basic educational qualifications for admission to the course shall be a recognized degree or diploma in any branch of technology or engineering or a recognized Bachelor's degree in science with Physics or Chemistry as one of the subjects.

2.2 Admission to the First Semester of Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Safety Management Course shall be made on the basis of marks/percentile obtained by the applicants at the National Entrance Examination such as CAT, JMET, XAT, MAT, ATMA etc. or the Test prescribed for the purpose from time to time and Group Discussion or Personal Interview or both carrying 50 marks to be conducted at such place and at such time by a Board constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

2.3 Employed candidates sponsored by those employers who are required under the law to appoint safety officers will be exempted from the criteria of Score/Percentile applicable for general candidate, provided they possess the basic educational qualifications as mentioned in clause 2.1 above and their merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks secured by them at the interview/Group discussion. The exemption shall also be applicable for candidates with degree or diploma in engineering.

2.4 20% of the seats shall be reserved for candidates sponsored by the employers provided that if suitable candidates are not available from this category candidates from general category will be admitted in their places.

2.5 Candidates sponsored by any State Govt. or Central Government shall be admitted on additional seats and but they must possess the qualification prescribed under clause 2.1 above.

3.0 Number of Seats

3.1 The total number of seats shall be sixty (60) including sponsored candidates.

4.0 The Course shall be conducted in the department of PMIR, Patna University.

5.0 No applicant shall be allowed admission to the course who had not applied for admission within the notified time.

6.0 The reservation of seats belonging to various categories shall be as per Patna University/Bihar Government rules.

7.0 Seats left unfilled in any of the category by reason of the fact that eligible candidate are not available shall be filled up by admitting applicants from amongst candidates available the other categories in order of ascending category.

**REGULATION FOR THE POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN
INDUSTRIAL SAFETY MANAGEMENT**

1. A person who has completed the prescribed courses of study for the prescribed period and has fulfilled all other requirements in this regard shall be eligible for admission to the examination in Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Safety Management of the University.
2. The duration of the courses shall be one year (two semester) commencing from the date as may be announced in this regard from time to time.
3. The prescribed courses of studies will consist of the following subjects grouped into 10 papers with one hundred as full marks in each paper.

The courses of studies will be reviewed from time to time by a Advisory Board to be nominated by the ce-Chancellor on the advice of the Head of the Department of Personnel Management & Industrial lations.

5. The examination shall be held twice every year at such place and time as fixed by the Examination Board.

6. In order to qualify for appearing in the examination a candidate must have attended at least 60 percent of the total lectures delivered and completed the field work training as stated in clause (3) above.

7. **Promotion Rules** - There shall be no supplementary examination in any of the semester courses (I or II).

The candidates who have been admitted to the First Semester of a 1-year Post Graduate Programme in the Semester. :

(a) Those who have appeared at the CIA and attended the required minimum percentage (75%) of attendance of lectures/practical classes or both or otherwise as per the provisions contained under the section 4 and 5 of chapter III of the old regulation of Patna University for appearing at the First Semester Examination and filled-up the examination form in time for appearing at the First Semester Examination;

(b) Those who have not attended the required minimum percentage of attendance (75%) for appearing at the First Semester Examination or have not filled-up the examination form in the time for appearing at the First Semester Examination.

Candidates under the category 1 are eligible for appearing at the First Semester Examination, while the candidates under category 2 shall not be allowed to appear at the First Semester Examination, but are allowed to seek readmission in the First Semester.

After appearing at the Semester Examination, the candidates can be placed in the following categories in the context of declaration of the results of the Semester Examination :

(i) A candidate shall be declared to have passed in a Semester Examination provided :
(a) He/She has secured at least 40% marks in each paper with the ESE and the CIA marks taken together and;

(b) He/She has secured at least 45% marks in the aggregate of all the papers of the Semester Examination.

(ii) Those who have not passed in the examination of all the papers of the First Semester shall be treated as promoted to the Second Semester.

(iii) Such candidates who have failed in the examination of the First Semester are allowed promotion of the Second Semester on the condition that they have to clear their First Semester Examination together with the Second Semester Examination.

(iv) Candidates shall have to clear all the papers of his course within the maximum period of three academic sessions from the date of his/her first admission to the semester programme.

After the examination, the Examination Board shall, as far as possible, publish a list of successful candidates arranged in order of merit.

Each successful candidate shall receive a Post Graduate Diploma in Industrial Safety Management in the prescribed form which will indicate the class in which he was placed.

Each candidate seeking admission to the course and to the examination shall pay such fee and other charges as may be prescribed from time to time in this regard.

The Vice-Chancellor shall have power to relax, with the approval of the Chancellor, any criteria and increase seats beyond the usual number of seats in the case of students (a) coming from foreign countries (b) nominated by the Government of India under various plan. (b) coming under scheme of any State Government approved by the Government of Bihar.
