SECOND AMENDMENT

TO

REGULATIONS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION PROGRAMME OF NALANDA OPEN UNIVERSITY

(110)

1. Short Title and Commencement:

These Regulations may be called "Second Amendment to Regulations for Bachelor of Education programme of Nalanda Open University." They shall come into effect from academic session 2015.

2. Delete **Clause 2.1** of the existing regulations and substitute them with new Clause as below:

"2.1 Course Structure

The course is essentially a judicious mix of theory and practical contents, designed to develop practicing teachers' knowledge, skill and attitude. The course will consist of 18 papers, spread over two academic years:

(A) First Year of Course:

First year of course will consist of 8 compulsory theoretical papers, each paper of 100 marks and one practical paper of 100 marks, as per details given below:

nine papers each. There shall be sixteen theoretical and two practical papers. Each theoretical paper shall consist of two parts.

- i. Written examination of 80 marks.
- ii. Evaluation of Assignment/practical of 20 marks."

4. Delete **Clause 4.1** of the existing regulations and substitute them with new Clause as below:

4.1.(a) A candidate is required to pass individually in each paper of the theoretical written examination and home assignment as also the practical examination.

(b) In order to pass Bachelor of Education (Part-I and Part-II), a candidate must obtain 33% marks in term end theory examination and assignment separately in each paper and 40% in each paper of the practical examination. Marks for which examination will be held for Part I and Part II and minimum marks required to pass the examination in each part is shown as below:
