# DRAFT ORDINANCE AND REGULATIONS FOR POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN DEFENCE MANAGEMENT & STRATEGIC STUDIES COURSE UNDER REGULAR MODE

#### ORDINANCE

#### Eligibility for Admission:

- (a) To be admitted to the course for Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management and Strategic Studies a candidate must have Bachelor's degree in any subject from any recognized University
- intake: OTA has proposed the total intake strength of trainees 750. At present the course shall commence with intake 100 (one hundred) which shall be enhanced from time to time by, the University as per availability of the trainees. The provision laid down under section 61 (2) of Bihar State Universities Act, 1976 (as amended up to date) is superseded by the policy laid down by Integrated Headquarters(Army), Ministry of Defence, Govt of India and only the pre-commission trainees will be enrolled for the said course.
- (c) No applicant shall be admitted who is not an Officer Trainee at Officer's Training Academy Gaya.

#### Registration:

Every Officer trainee has to be registered under Magadh University by paying the requisite Registration Fee to Magadh University, Bodhgaya.

#### 3. Migration Certificate:

Those Officer trainees who are not registered with Magadh University shall have to submit migration certificate.

#### 4. Course Fee:

No tuition fee shall be charged from admitted student by the University. However a candidate shall have to hav Rs 1255/- (one thousand two hundred fifty five) to the University as Registration and Examination fees

#### REGULATIONS

Regulation and Syllabus for admission to "Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management & Strategic Studies" under Magadh University, Bodh Gaya which will be run only at Officers Training Academy, Gaya (Integrated Headquarters (Army), Ministry of Defence, Govt of India).

Duration

One (1) year duration.

Eligibility: Bachelor's Degree from any recognized University in any subject.

Medium of Instruction: English.

#### 1 Scheme of Evaluation:

The evaluation comprises of final examinations in two Semesters. To complete the course, the learner is required to secure a minimum of 45% in the final examination.

#### Delivery System

The Methodology of instruction in this course shall be different from that of conventional courses. It will be more learners oriented and the Officer Trainee would be an active participant in the teaching-learning process.

A variety of instructional methods of integrated multimedia approach as given under are being followed for effective teaching-learning.

- (a) Printed materials
- (b) Contact Classes
- (c) Audio Visual aids.
- (d) Lecture cum demonstration method.
- (e) Practical Classes.
- (f) Guest Lectures
- (g) Co-Curricular Activities

#### 4. Attendance Policy:

It is mandatory for all Officer Trainees (Gentleman Cadets) to attend a minimum of 75% attendance for all classes.

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#### Practical Training:

All Officer Trainees are required to go for practical training in concerned subjects for salessage as per as labus

#### 6. Medium of Instruction and Examination

- (a) The medium of instruction and examination for the course will be English.
- (b) The examinations leading to the award of the degree will be held at end of each semester (1st term and 2nd Term).
- (c) The mode of instruction shall comprise of printed précis in English. Contact classes, Lecture cum demonstration method, audio-visual aids and practical training.
- (d) Course of study for Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management and Strategic Studies examination is as prescribed by the Army Training Command, Shimla, under Integrated Headquarters (Army), New Delhi.

#### 7. Registration:

To be admitted to the examination for the Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management & Strategic Studies a candidate must have:

- (i) Completed the course of study for Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management & Strategic Studies prescribed by Magadh University Bodhgaya.
- (ii) Registered with the University.

#### Conduct of Examination

- (a) Each exam paper shall comprise of objective, short answers and subjective questions.
- (b) The students are required to appear for the University examination at the end of each semester (term).
- (c) A candidate having completed the course has to appear for the written examination and practical tests as per syllabus.
- (d) A candidate having completed the course fails to appear at the examination or fails to pass the examination or does not clear any paper shall be allowed to appear at the subsequent examination in only that/those part/s and which he/she has failed or absented himself/herself without being required to go through the course again. However, this opportunity shall be given in only two more examinations within a period not exceeding two year excluding the main examination held at the end of the semester/term.
- There shall be provision to carry over the examination. The result of the final examination shall not be published till he /she appears and passes in the paper which he has not completed for some reasons.



- (f) The examination shall be held at Officer's Training Academy Gaya under the guidelines of Magadh University, Bodhgaya as per the training programme of Officer's Training Academy, Gaya. The examination centre will be decided by Magadh University, Bodhgaya at the sprawling campus of Officers Training Academy, Gaya.
- (g) The list of question setters and examiners will be approved by Magadh University, Bodhgaya from the list provided by Officers Training Academy Gaya. After getting approval of setters and evaluators from Magadh University, Bodhgaya, the Officers Training Academy Gaya will conduct the examination and publication of results shall be processed by Magadh University, Bodhgaya.
- (h) In order to pass the Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management & Strategic Studies a candidate must have passed both the two semesters of examinations separately.

#### 8. Publication of Results

- (a) The list of successful candidates of the Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management and Strategic Studies examination shall be published in their order of merit by Officers Training Academy, Gaya.
- (b) The name of successful candidates shall be arranged in order of merit as follows:
  - (i) Candidate who obtained 75 % or more will be placed in First Class with Distinction.
  - (ii) Candidate who obtained 60% but less than 75% marks shall be placed in first class.
  - (iii) Candidates who obtained 45% but less than 60% marks shall be placed in Second Class.
  - (iv) Candidates who obtained less than 45% marks in aggregate shall be deemed to have failed.

#### Award of Degree

The Officers trainees who complete the course successfully shall be awarded Post Graduate Diploma in Defence Management and Strategic Studies by Magadh University, Bodhgaya in the prescribed format specifying the Class / Division in which he/she is placed.
