# BACHELOR OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION (B.P.Ed.) PROGRAMME

### Regular Mode

(Under Self-Finance Scheme)

Regulation and Ordinance for Admission in Two year Bachelor of Physical Programme

### REGULATION

### 1. Preamble

- 1.1 The Bachelor of Physical Education programme, generally known as B. P. Ed. shall be a professional programme meant for preparing leaders of physical educational from classes VI to X and for conducting physical educational and sports activities in classes XI and XII.
- 1.2 The Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) programme shall run under the faculty of Education.

### 2. **Duration of Course**

- 2.1 The B.P.Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic years; i.e. four semesters. However, the students shall be permitted to complete the programme within a maximum of three academic years.
  - 2.2 A University examination shall be held after completing each academic year

## 2.3 Working Days

- 2.3.1 There shall be at least two hundred working days in each year excluding the period of examination and admission.
- 2.3.2 The institution shall work for a minimum of thirty six hours in a week. (five or six days).

#### 2.4 Curriculum

B.P.Ed. programme shall be designed to integrate the Study of Childhood, Social context of Physical Education, Subject knowledge, Pedagogical knowledge, Aims of Physical Education and Communication Skills. The programme shall comprise of compulsory and optional theory papers as well as practical papers and compulsory school internship.

## 3. Registration

Every student, who is not registered with the University shall have to be registered with the University on payment of the requisite fee.

### 4. Examination

- 4.1 To be permitted to appear in the examination for the Degree of the Bachelor of Physical Education (B. P. Ed), a candidate must have:
- (i) Completed the courses of study as prescribed for the B.P. Ed. Programme
- (ii) Registered with the University as a student.
- (iii) Completed 80% attendance in theory classes and 90% in school internship and practicals of the total classes held.
- 4.2 A candidate for Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P. Ed.) degree shall be examined in twenty papers carrying a total of 2000 marks.
- (a) There shall be five core courses and One optional course carrying 100 marks each (80 marks for Theory & 20 marks for Internal assessment)
- (b) There shall be teaching practice course to be offered in areas such as teaching theory, games and athletics teaching, course carrying 200 marks in each year (120 marks for External & 80 marks for Internal assessment.)
- (c) There shall be school Internship programme for 200 marks (100 in each year) in two years. The marks shall be awarded on the basis of overall performance of the student-teachers in the school during Internship programme. The institution shall maintain cumulative record of activities of each student-teacher interaction during Internship programme for the assessment of overall performance.
- 4.3 The Written examination in each of the theoretical core papers & optional papers shall be of four hours duration.

- 4.4 For the evaluation of School Internship programme there shall be provision of one external examination to be conducted by the University after completion of School Internship programme in 2<sup>nd</sup> year.
- 4.5 The medium of examination of course shall be Hindi/English/Urdu

A candidate who has completed the course, fails to appear at the examination or fails to pass the examination, shall be allowed to take subsequent examination on payment of prescribed examination fee without being required to complete the course again. However this opportunity shall be given only for one time within a period not exceeding three years from the date of admission.

4.7 If any student fails in not more than two theory papers in 1<sup>st</sup> year, he/she shall be promoted to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year course. But he/she will have to clear all the backlogue papers before he/she is permitted in the final year examination.

### 5. Conduct of Examination and Moderation of Results

- 5.1 The examination shall be conducted by the University. University shall also finalize the programme for the examination and charge necessary examination fee to conduct the examination.
- 5.2 In order to pass Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) examination, a candidate shall have to obtain at least 45% marks in each theory paper and 50% marks in each practical paper separately. A candidate not securing the above qualifying marks shall be declared as fail.
- 5.3 The name of successful candidate shall be arranged in order of merit as follows:

5.4 The Vice-Chancellor/Examination Board of the concerned University may condone deficiency up to 5 marks (if a candidate is failing in not more than one paper or missing a Division/Class/Grade by not more than 5 marks). If a candidate fails in two subjects there shall be no relaxation and the candidate shall be deemed to have failed in the examination.

### ORDINANCE FOR ADMISSION

## 1. Admission and Selection Procedure

- 1.1 The selection of candidates for admission to the Bachelor of Physical Education programme (B.P.Ed.) in Regular mode shall be made on the basis of merit obtained in Gradation & Sports Achievement, after successful qualifying Physical Efficiency test.
- 1.2 The fee for appearing in the Physical Efficiency Test shall be Rs. 1000/- for General and Others & Rs. 500/- for SC/ST candidates. The Physical Efficiency Test fee may be revised by the competent authority as and when required.

  Appearance in the Physical Efficiency test shall be mandatory.
- 1.3 Reservation of seats for the candidates of reserved categories shall strictly be implemented as per State Government's rules.
- 1.4 Seats shall be reserved for SC [16%], ST [01%] BC-I [18 %] BC-II [12%] & BC Women [03 %]. The reserved category candidates shall have to submit a copy of the caste certificate of that effect issued by the competent authority.
- 1.5 Reservation of Seats provided in the general ordinance for admission shall be applicable only when candidate fulfills the minimum eligibility requirement.
- 1.6 Physical Efficiency Test shall be conducted centrally by the University. Date of Physical Efficiency Test will be announced sufficiently in advance by the University and merit list shall also be prepared by the University.
- 1.7 List of admitted students shall be published by the University within one month of declaration of the merit list.
- 1.8 After providing the opportunity for admission to the candidates in descending order of merit, if the reservation percentage of any reserved category is not filled up, vacant seats shall be exchanged as per State Govt. rules.
- 1.9 If at any time it is found that the candidate has furnished any false information, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately and the deposited fee shall be forfeited and suitable legal action would be initiated.
- 1.11 The concerned University shall reserve the right to take any decision in all matters of admission and it shall be final.

2.1 Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having participation in the Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/District/School completion in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India

Or

- 2.2 Bachelor's degree in physical education with 45% marks.
- 2.3 Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks, where the candidate has studied physical education as a compulsory/elective subject.

Or

2.4 Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University/State competitions or secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position Inter College/ Inter-Zonal/ District/School completion in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India

Or

2.5 Bachelor's degree with participation in International competitions or secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

Or

2.6 Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained physical education teacher coaches.

#### 3. Intake

There shall be the basic unit of 50 students, with a maximum of two units. This intake capacity may be modified as per norms and guidelines prescribed by NCTE from time-to-time

#### 4. Fee

4.1 The fee structure for the two year (B.P.Ed.) course shall be as mentioned below:
